1. The decision:

- 1.1. That a traffic order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be to prohibit vehicles from that length of Priestley Road at Basingstoke, between its junction with Park Prewett Road (also known locally as The Avenue) and a point 6 metres south-east thereof.

2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. No objections or representations were received in response to the public consultation which took place between 16 October and 6 November 2015.
- 2.2. The proposed prohibition of driving order is associated with a major junction improvement planned as part of the wider improvements to the A340 Aldermaston Road. As part of the changes to the A340 junction with Park Prewett Road, a prohibition of driving order is required to close the Park Prewett Road / Priestley Road junction to enable signalisation of the A340 with dedicated lanes to help improve safety at the junction.
