1. The decision:

1.1. That a Traffic Order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to extend the existing 30 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit as follows:

- (i) C10 at Burley Street between a point 295 metres west of its junction with Coach Hill Lane and a point 101 metres north-west of its junction with C104 Moortown Lane / C10 Picket Plain Common, an approximate distance of 115 metres.
- (ii) C10 Picket Plain Common spur for its entire length, an approximate distance of 80 metres.
- (iii) C10 Ringwood Road / C104 Moortown Lane between a point 295 metres west of its junction with Coach Hill Lane and a point 125 metres south-west of its junction with C104 Moortown Lane, an approximate distance of 135 metres.

1.2 The order will also revoke and re-enact the provisions contained in existing orders with no change of substance save for the addition of the restrictions described above.

2. Reasons for the decision:

2.1. The proposal is in response to calls from the Parish Council and backed by the County Councillor, to review the speed limit on the western approach into the village.

This proposal, which will have the effect of enhancing the safety of residents and non-motorised road users in light of a severe bend, has the support of the Police.

4. Existing Orders

4.1 In addition, the Traffic Order shall contain the same provisions as set out in 'The Hampshire (Various Roads, Burley) (Restricted Road) Order 2000 and shall revoke that Order.

The Hampshire (Various Roads New Forest South) (40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 1992, will also be revoked *insomuch as it relates to Item (15) Picket Plain Common.*
