1. The decision:

- 1.1. That a traffic order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be to consolidate and re-enact the provisions contained in the following orders with no change of substance save for minor amendments to descriptions:
- (i) The County of Southampton (Built Up Areas) (No.2) Order 1936 - *Schedule 2 – Farnborough Urban District only*
 - (ii) The County of Southampton (Built Up Areas) (No.1) Order 1948
 - (iii) The Hampshire (40 mph Speed Limit) (No.6) Order 1965
 - (iv) The Urban District of Farnborough (Restricted Roads) (No.1) Order 1968
 - (v) The Urban District of Farnborough (40 mph Speed Limit) (Farnborough Road) Order 1971
 - (vi) The Hampshire (Cove) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 1972
 - (vii) The Hampshire (Various Roads, Hawley) (Restricted Roads) Order 1982
 - (viii) The Hampshire (Fernhill Road, Hawley) (Restricted Road) Order 1983 – *That length of restricted road now in Rushmoor.*
 - (ix) The Hampshire (Summit Avenue and Ively Road, Southwood, Farnborough) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1991

- (x) The Borough of Rushmoor (Bramshot Lane, Minley Road, Sandy Lane and Trunk Road, Farnborough) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 1992
- (xi) The Borough of Rushmoor (Various Roads in Aldershot and Farnborough) (30 and 40 mph Speed Limit and Clearway) Order 1994 – *Article 2 and Schedule 1 only*
- (xii) The Borough of Rushmoor (Summit Avenue, Southwood, Farnborough) (40 Miles per Hour Speed Limit and Prohibition of Right Turn) Order 1997 – *Article 1 and 40 mph Schedule only.*
- (xiii) The Hampshire (A3013 / B3014 and A327, Cove) (50 Miles per Hour Speed Limit) Order 1997
- (xiv) The Borough of Rushmoor (Various Roads in Aldershot) (30 and 40 mph Speed Limits and Prohibition of Waiting and Revocation) Order 1998 – *Articles 3 and 4 and Schedules 1 and 2 only.*
- (xv) The Hampshire (Herrett Street Area, Aldershot) (20 mph Speed Limit) Order 1998
- (xvi) The Borough of Rushmoor (Elles Road and Ively Road, Farnborough) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2001
- (xvii) The Rushmoor Borough Council (20 mph, 30 mph and 40 mph Speed Limits) (Consolidation) Order 2006
- (xviii) The Hampshire (Various Roads, Farnborough) (20 Miles per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2013
- (xix) The Hampshire (Various Roads, Blackwater, Yateley, Hawley and Farnborough) (Restricted Road, 30 and 40 Miles per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2016 – *Schedule III, item (iv) A325 Farnborough Road only.*

2. Reason for the decision:

- 2.1. This consolidation order will rectify errors made by Rushmoor Borough Council over the years, whereby new orders have been made amending descriptions but the old orders were never revoked or, as in 2006 when a consolidation order was made which should have revoked those other orders, this was not actually valid as Part IV of Schedule 9 was not listed in the order.

Over the years a number of orders have been made which relate to the same locality and by consolidating it will make it easier for everyone to find both the relevant roads and the speed limits applicable which, at present, is time consuming given that some orders may relate to only one length of road and some older orders may cover several districts, where it is easy to miss one length. Also, separate lengths of one road

may appear in two or more orders. Minor amendments to descriptions may also be required for clarity, particularly with older orders where building names or even lamp-posts were used as points of reference.
