1. The decision:

- 1.1. That a traffic order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be to impose a 30mph speed limit (existing 40mph) on that length of Anstey Lane between its junction with C124 Old Odiham Road and a point 411 metres south-east thereof.
- 1.2. The order will revoke and reinstate the provisions contained in The Hampshire (Old Odiham Road/Anstey Lane, Alton (Restricted Road and 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 1995

2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. No objections or representations were received in response to the public consultation which took place between 10 and 31 October 2014.
- 2.2. The order is proposed following concerns expressed about safety generally and the speed and volume of traffic along the residential section of Anstey Lane from its junction with Old Odiham Road. In line with current speed management policy it is proposed that a 30mph speed limit be implemented for this section of road.
