#### 1. The decision:

- 1.1. That a Traffic Order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a 40 mph speed limit on the currently de-restricted C12 Bagmore Lane between its junction with A339 and a point 120 metres east of its junction with Scratchface Lane (unmetalled), an approximate distance of 1,315 metres.

#### 2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. The order is proposed in response to public concern about road safety in general, as well as the Parish Council's request for a reduced speed limit to protect the community life in Bagmore.


