1. Executive Summary

- 1.1. The purpose of this report is to seek approval for the Chiltern Way Environmental Improvements scheme.
- 1.2. This proposed scheme builds on the success of the recent Old Kempshott Lane Accessibility Improvements and seeks to improve accessibility for pedestrians near Chiltern Primary School and for all users trying to reach Basingstoke Leisure Park.
- 1.3. The scheme will cost £350,000 and is funded entirely by developer contributions. It makes it quicker, safer and more secure for pedestrians to access the Chiltern Primary School site and implements several of the recommendations from the school's travel plan. It also addresses a noted missing link in the cycle network of the town, thereby encouraging travel by sustainable means.
- 1.4. If approved, the proposed scheme will start on site in early 2012.

2. Recommendation

- 2.1 That the Project Appraisal for the Chiltern Way Environmental Improvements, at a cost of £350,000 funded by developer contributions, be approved.
