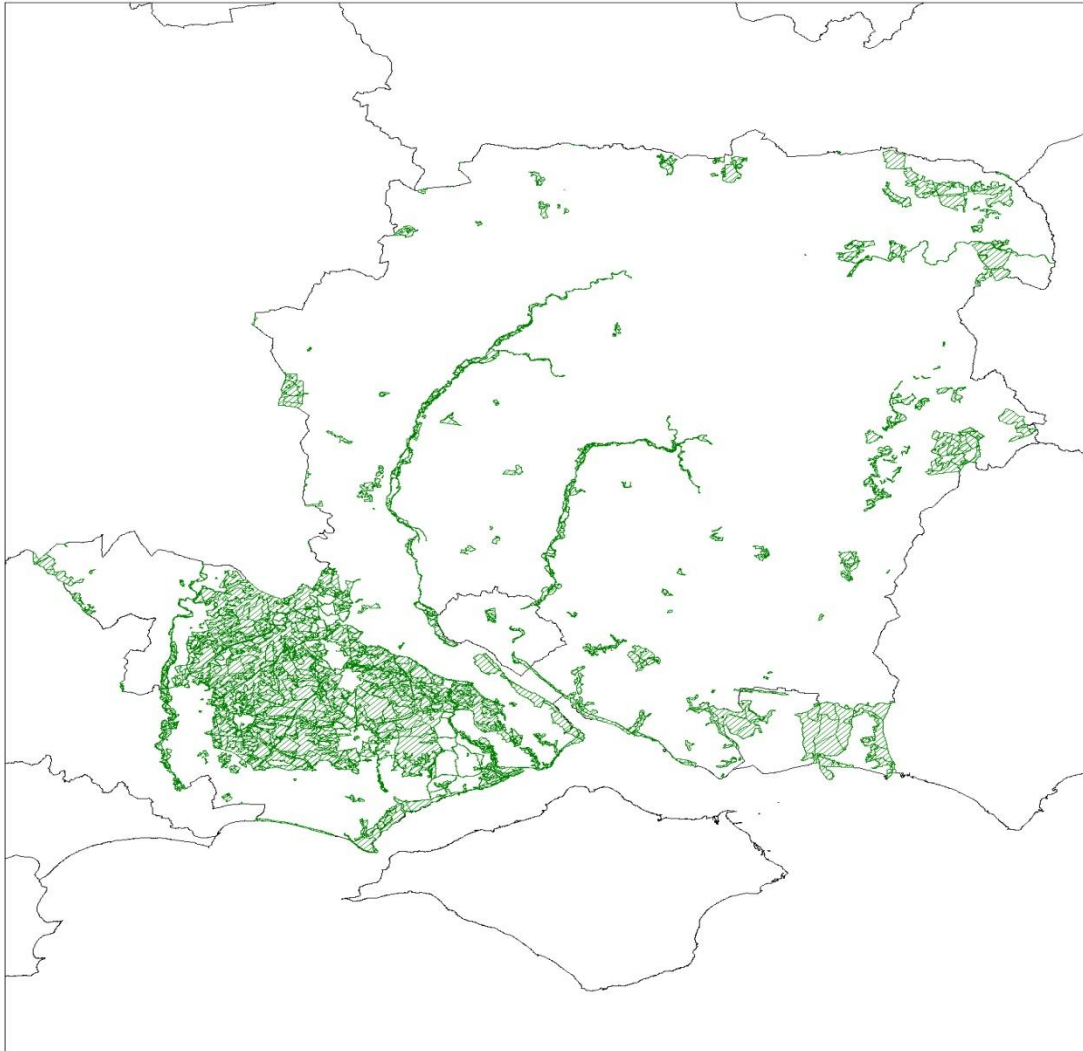
South East Protected Landscapes



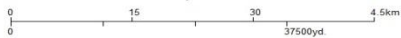
South East region and London region - designated and defined interests

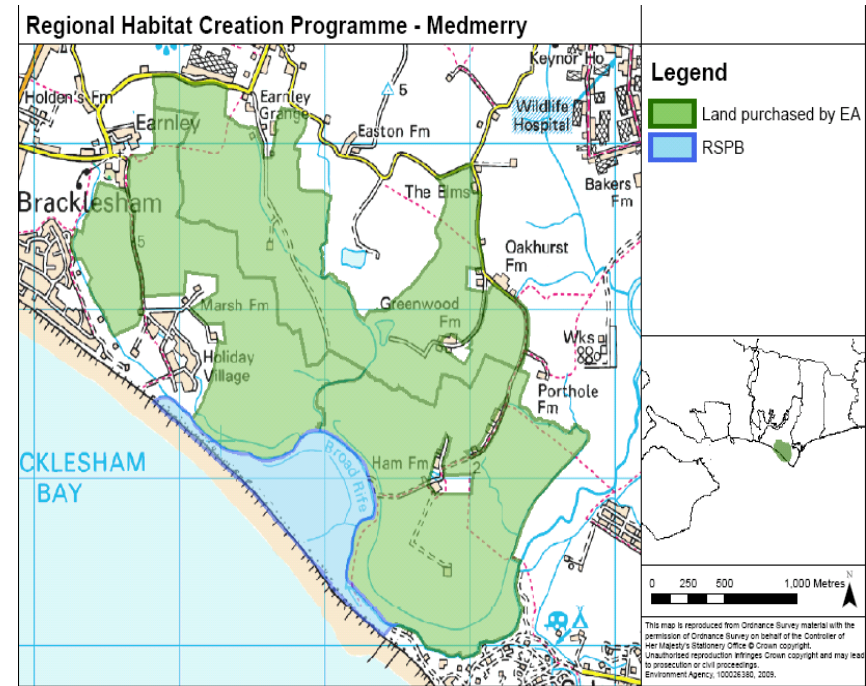

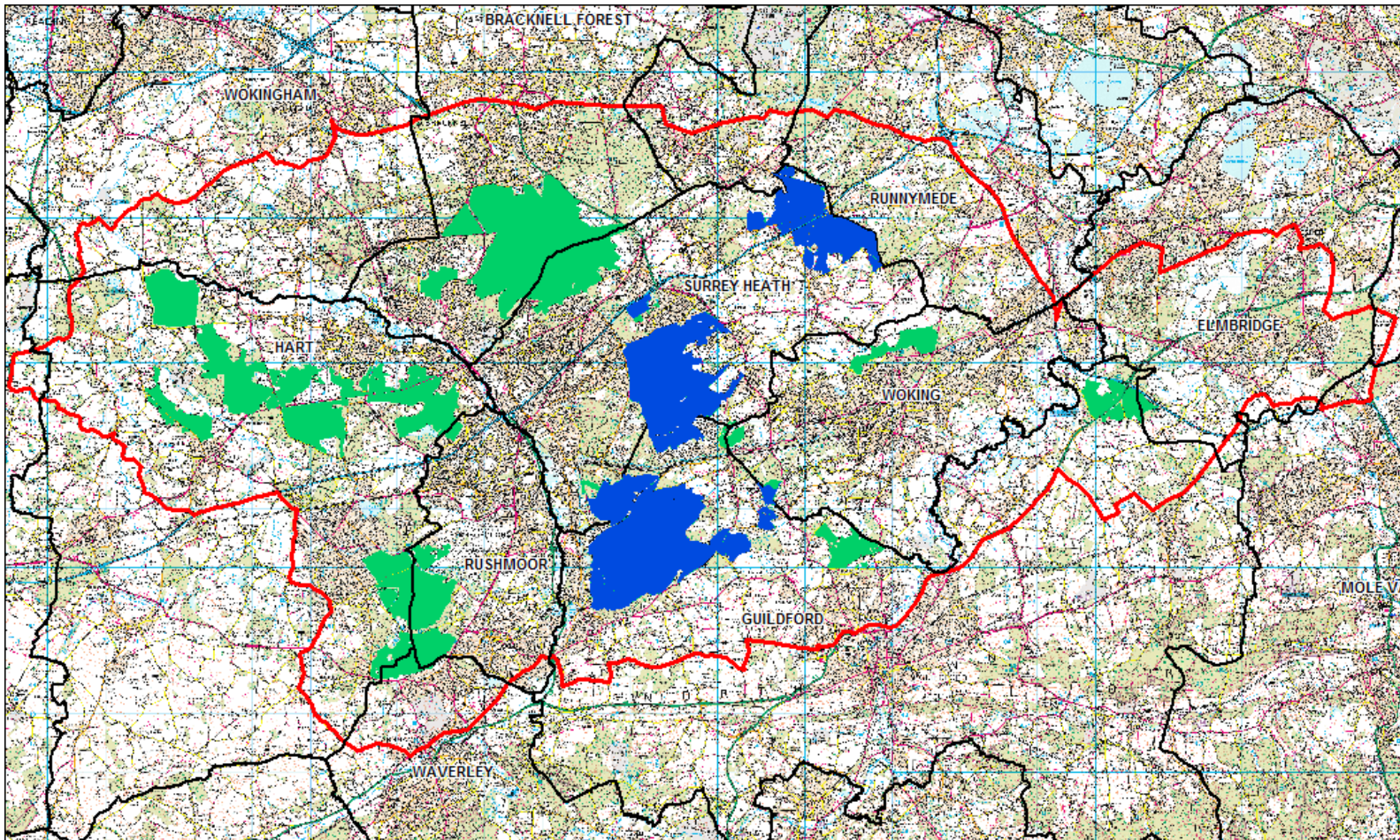

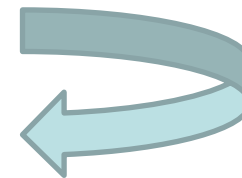
Thames Basin Heaths Special Protection Area - Planning Zone

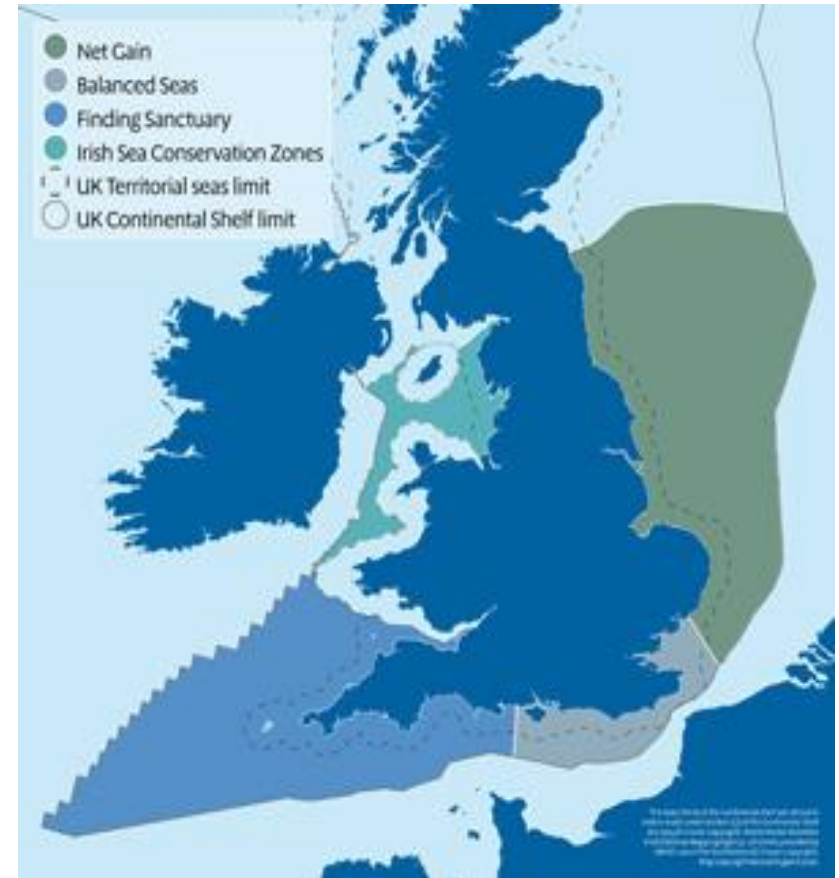
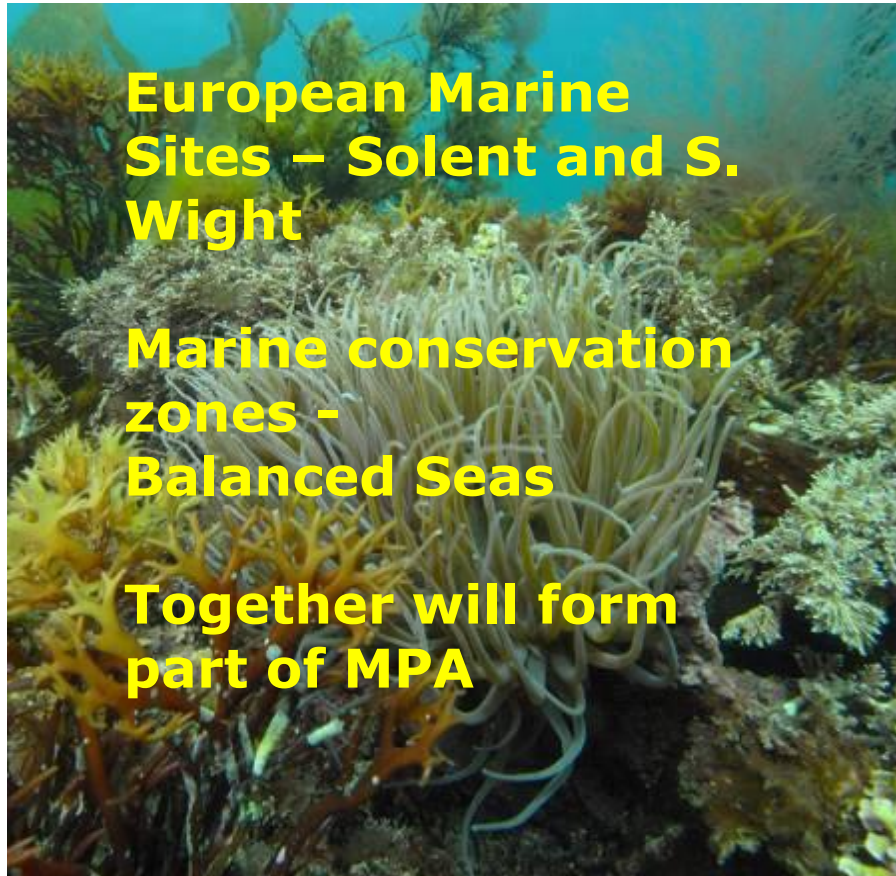

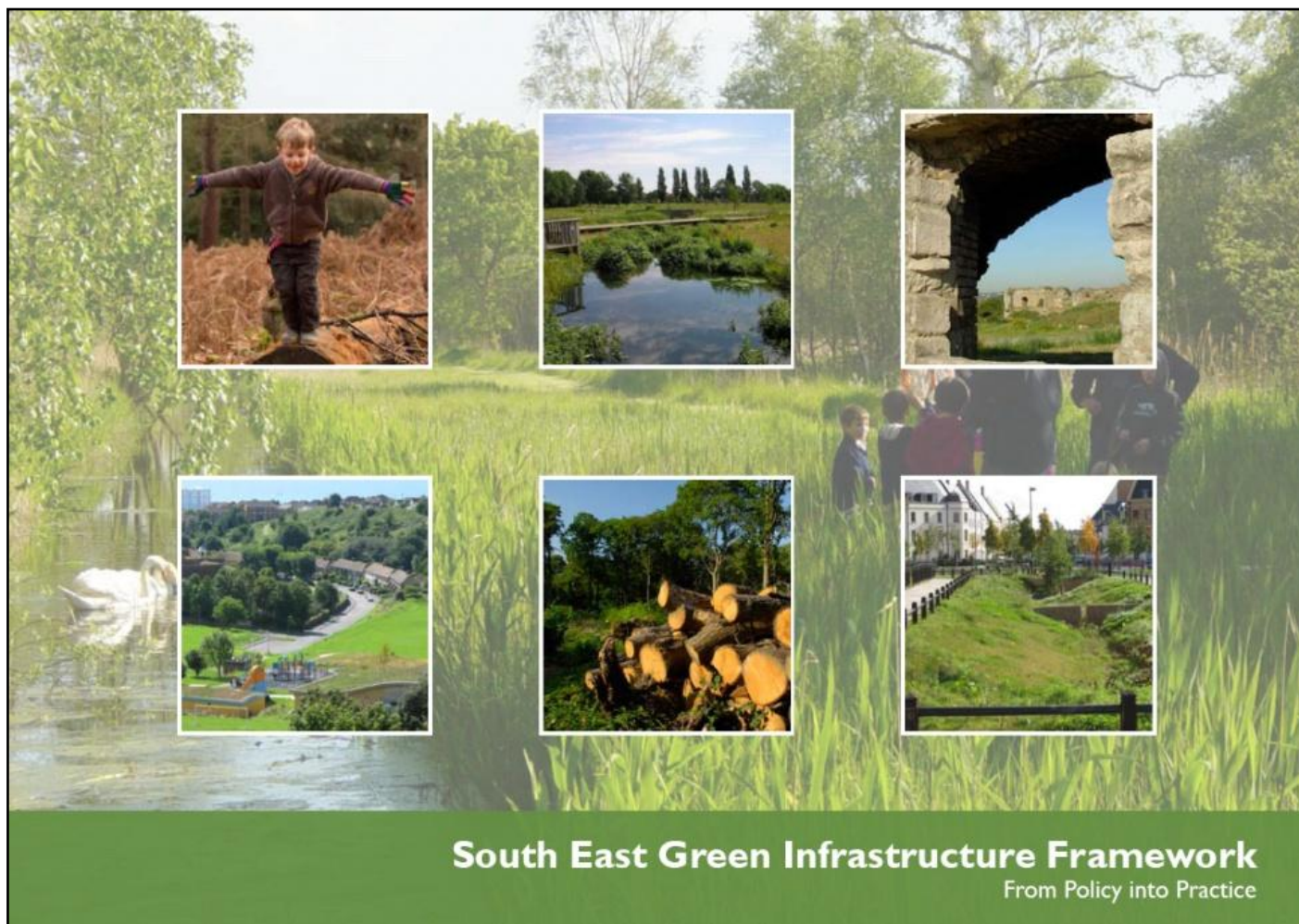
The future?

- More Volunteer Health Walk leaders coming from communities with health inequalities.

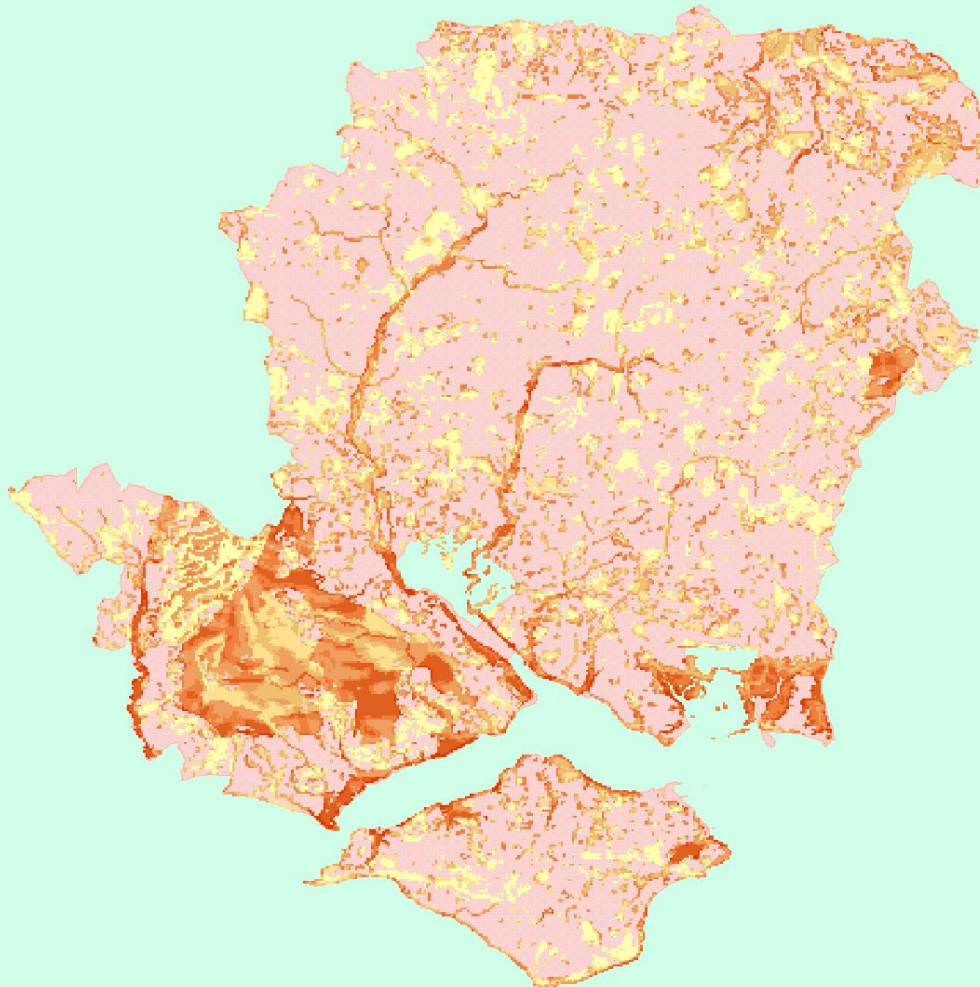

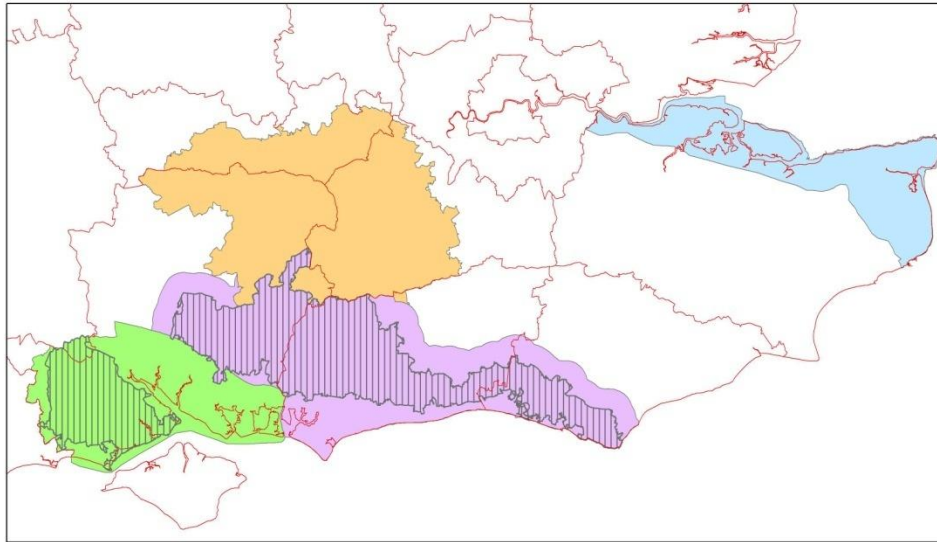

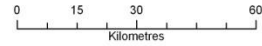


Natural England's Spatial Projects in the South East region



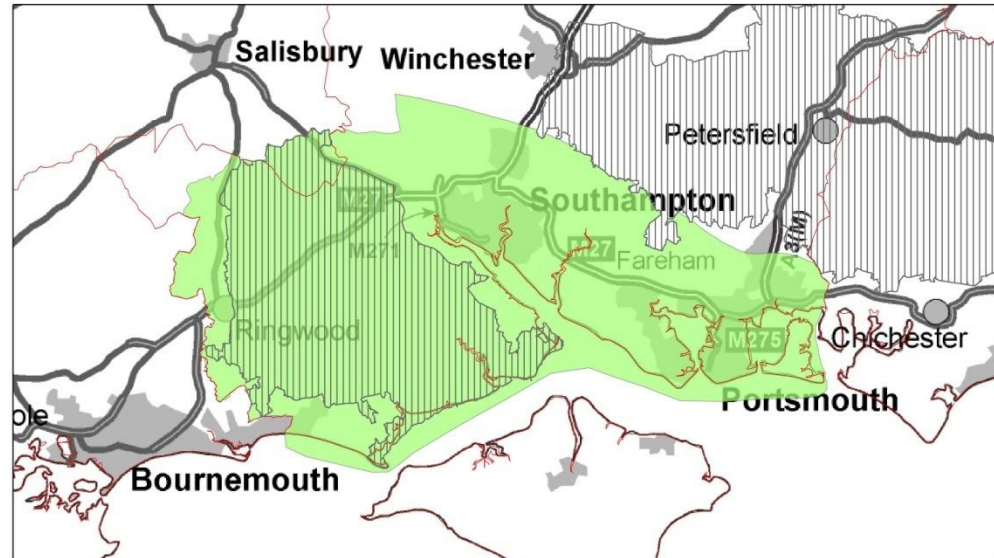

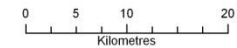
