- 3.11. 14 Nov. Patrol attended a Canoe race.
- 3.12. 17 Nov. Patrol freed snagged mooring lines on a pile-moored yacht.
- 3.13. 18 Nov. Patrol responded to a Police call to investigate items possibly shed from a lorry into the river at the M27 bridge. Nothing found.
- 3.14. 19 Nov. Patrol investigated a report of theft of pontoon planking at Swanwick Marina.
- 3.15. 21 Nov. Patrol attended fouled moorings on a yacht.
- 3.16. 22 Nov. Patrol attended grounded vessel – floated off safely on a rising tide.
- 3.17. 27 Nov. Patrol attended yacht with a parted mooring in foul weather.
- 3.18. 28 Nov. Patrol assisted yacht with fouled propeller. Towed to safety alongside.
- 3.19. 2 Dec. Patrol liaised with Coast Guard to attend a dinghy caught fast on Hamble Spit.
- 3.20. 3 Dec. Patrol responded to a report of commercial bait digging and not re-filling arisings. Bait diggers had departed before arrival on scene.
- 3.21. 5 Dec. Patrol responded to vessel grounded on a rising tide on Hook Spit. Vessel freed herself.
