

Addendum to Agenda Item 7 of the Meeting of the River Hamble Harbour Management Committee on Friday 24 June 2016

- 3.48. 09 June. Patrol responded jointly with Hampshire Police to a report of an altercation near the Jolly Sailor PH. 2 members of the public arrested on public order offences. RHHA also co-ordinated ambulance response to a dismasted yacht, one of whose crew had suffered a head injury. Calshot Lifeboat, the Coastguard and South Central Ambulance Service involved. Casualty brought to Warsash Jetty in accordance with Standard Operating Procedures for treatment. Casualty released on completion. Patrol then towed a dinghy from H45 to Hamble Jetty. Patrol responded jointly with Hampshire Police to a report of youths swimming and climbing on boats at Lands End, liaising with owners. Strong ebb meant that Patrol was required to recover stranded swimmers to shore for Police questioning.
- 3.49 10 June. RHHA responded to report from HMCG of inbound yacht with head injury. HMCG on this occasion directed yacht to Port Hamble Marina, contrary to RHHA SOP, without informing RHHA. This incident is the subject of ongoing investigation. All authorities have been reminded of the RHHA SOP.
- 3.50. 11 June. Patrol responded to a report of an unberthing incident and placed owners of affected boats in touch with the yacht in question. Minor damage incurred. Patrol responded to report of suspicious individuals photographing boats at Riverside Boatyard. Police informed in accordance with Project Kraken SOP.
- 3.51. 12 June. Patrol witnessed a white Ford Transit Van suspected of fly tipping, unloading a trailer on Swanwick Road Car Park. Police informed and attended the scene.
- 3.52. 13 June. Patrol responded to a report from a member of the public that overgrown weeds were impeding the safety of navigation just South of Botley Bridge. On attending, no risk to navigation witnessed.
- 3.53. 14 June. Patrol noticed a RIB adrift and apparently Not Under Command off Warsash College. On attending, Skipper had run out of fuel. Patrol stood by while emergency fuel supply selected.
- 3.54. 15 June. Patrol responded to a call of fishing nets impeding the safety of navigation North of M27. Nets recovered and advice given to fisherman. Well-received.
- 3.55. 16 June. Patrol responded to a report of a minor fuel spill at Port Hamble fuel jetty. Patrol towed yacht to Swanwick for lift out.
- 3.56. 17 June. Patrol attended Manor Farm Jetty for litter collection. Patrol attended yacht on behalf of deceased estate to pump out bilges. Preparation for Hamble River Games. Laying of open water swimming course in Warsash Pool.

- 3.57. 18 June. RHHA supported the third Hamble River Games afloat and ashore. Event very well supported with a significant increase in competitors over previous events. The Harbour Master would like to thank publicly those boat owners who, without exception, accommodated the safe passage of the various competitions. He would also like to thank Marina Operators and Boatyard for the way in which they advertised the event in advance. There is no doubt that this contributed to enhanced safety on the day. On completion, Patrol recovered swimming marks.
- 3.58. 18 June. Patrol assisted yacht with steering gear failure to mid-stream pontoon pending defect rectification.
- 3.59. 19 June. Investigated report of near collision between a motor boat and a launch. Patrol responded to a report of a minor collision involving a motor boat and a berthed yacht at Port Hamble. Patrol pursued motor boat and placed master in touch with owner of yacht, reminding former of byelaw 9.
- 3.60. 20 June. Patrol assisted a French yacht NOMADE and a local yacht RHYTHM BEAT, following a collision outside the River the previous evening.
- 3.61. 21 June. Patrol responded to a report of crabbing pots in Main Channel between number 5 and number 7 piles. On arrival, pots had been recovered. Patrol attempted to assist Sea Cadets in location of lost Laser Pico rudder. Nothing found.
