

River Hamble Harbour Management Committee – 26 June 2015

Incidents and Events

The following incidents and events occurred in the period from 7 June 2015 to 26 June 2015:

- 1.1 7 Jun. Patrol assisted a motor yacht with engine problems and towed it to its home berth (for which a towage fee was charged).
- 1.2 11 Jun. A written warning was issued to the owner of a PWC found exceeding the speed limit.
- 1.3 11 Jun. A casualty with a head injury sustained whilst racing was brought to the Harbour Office for first aid. Paramedics attended and the casualty was transferred to hospital.
- 1.4 12 Jun. Patrol assisted a yacht with engine problems and towed it to a safe berth.
- 1.5 15 Jun. Emergency services attended following reports of a dead body in the River, upstream from the Harbour Office. Patrol provided water-based assistance for the emergency services' mud rescue team which recovered the body. This incident is not thought to have any safety implications for the Harbour Authority.
- 1.6 17 Jun. Patrol discovered minor fire damage to the Manor Farm pontoon, thought to be caused by a barbeque. Country Park staff were informed.
- 1.7 18 Jun. Harbour Staff assisted the Coastguard and Paramedics with a casualty brought into the harbour after an incident that occurred in Southampton water.
- 1.8 19 Jun. Patrol assisted a vessel with engine failure and towed it to a safe berth.
- 1.9 20 Jun. Patrol assisted a vessel with engine failure and towed it to a safe berth.
- 1.10 21 Jun. Harbour Office staff assisted a casualty with a head injury sustained whilst racing. Ambulance attended.
