THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012 ('the Regulations')

REGULATION 10 - KEY DECISIONS

Regulation 10 (general exception) allows for a key decision to be made if it is impracticable for notice of the intention to take a key decision under Regulation 9 to be given 28 clear days in advance of the taking of the decision. It sets out the actions required to be taken in those circumstances which includes giving public notice at least five working days before the decision is taken.

The Cabinet intends to take a key decision on Quarter One Budget Monitoring - 2012/13 at a meeting on Monday 24 September 2012 at 10.30am at The Castle, Winchester.

The report outlines the key issues arising from the budget monitoring over the first quarter of the 2012-2013 financial year, including a proposal for a £1m increase in the capital programme for the purchase of additional vehicles, the borrowing costs for which will be met by reserves or additional income streams generated by Hampshire Transport Management.

It was impracticable to give the required 28 days notice of the Cabinet's intention to take this key decision due to the Regulations coming into force on 10 September 2012 and the proposed decision date of 24 September 2012 not allowing for 28 days to elapse.
