THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012 ('the Regulations')

REGULATION 10 - KEY DECISIONS

Regulation 10 (general exception) allows for a key decision to be made if it is impracticable for notice of the intention to take a key decision under Regulation 9 to be given 28 clear days in advance of the taking of the decision. It sets out the actions required to be taken in those circumstances which includes giving public notice at least five working days before the decision is taken.

The Cabinet intends to take a key decision on the Supporting Troubled Families Programme at a meeting on Monday 29 October 2012 at 11.00am at The Castle, Winchester.

The report provides an overview of the Supporting Troubled Families Programme in Hampshire, and seeks approval for the proposed strategic delivery approach and associated funding arrangements.

It was impracticable to give 28 days notice of this decision due to the late determination that the recommendations, if agreed, would amount to a key decision.
