THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012 ('the Regulations')

REGULATION 11 - KEY DECISIONS

Regulation 11 (cases of special urgency) allows for a key decision to be made if it is impracticable for notice of the intention to take a key decision under Regulation 10 to be given 5 clear days in advance of the taking of the decision. Regulation 11 sets out the actions required to be taken in those circumstances which include setting out the reasons why the meeting is urgent and cannot reasonably be delayed.

The Executive Member for Culture and Recreation intends to take a key decision on the progress and further review of the Mobile Library Service at a meeting on Thursday 27 September 2012 at 2.00pm at The Castle, Winchester.

The report seeks the approval of the Executive Member for Culture and Recreation for changes to the Mobile Library Service to enable best use of the service by as many people as possible.

Although this item was included in a previously published Forward Plan, this matter is considered urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred. The decision needs to be taken on this date so as not to delay efficiency improvements within the mobile library service for the residents of Hampshire.

The Chairman of the Culture, Communities and Rural Affairs Select Committee has consented to this decision being taken pursuant to Regulation 11.
