1. The decision: (PROPOSED)

- a) The Salt Barns and Salt Bins schemes be consolidated into one programme within the Environment Capital Programme totalling £1.1m funded from corporate allocations already made, and remove the requirement for the Environment Department to match fund £0.5m following the loss of LPSA reward grant.
- b) That the principle of 'school and community' salt routes to supplement the defined priority 1 and 2 routes be endorsed.
- c) That the progress on the winter maintenance review be noted, and in particular the:
 - (i) construction of the first salt storage barn at Micheldever highways depot, including the necessary actions under the lease to secure the site;
 - (ii) increase in the county-wide salt stock holding to 18,000 tonnes for the winter 2010/11 and beyond;
 - (iii) procurement, placing and maintenance of a first phase of 1,000 extra salt bins on the highway network; and
 - (iv) review of the existing Priority One and Priority Two Winter Maintenance routes in the light of experience from last winter and other relevant changes.

2. Reason for the decision:

2.1. To increase the County Council’s resilience during severe winter events as requested by Cabinet in January 2010.
