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Details of the Bid / Project

Title of Bid/ Project	Young Carers project to take group of Eastleigh young carers to Calshot Activities Centre.
Summary of Bid/ Project	<p>Young Carers are children who look after someone in their family who has an illness, a disability, a mental health problem or a substance misuse problem, taking on practical and/or emotional caring responsibilities that would normally be expected of an adult.</p> <p>Young carers invariably “miss out” on much of their childhood compared to their peers and are disadvantaged. Frequently young carers have low levels of self esteem and self confidence. They get limited opportunities to play and mix with their peers. Young carers may also have poor school attendance.</p> <p>This project aims to take a group of approximately 20 young carers to Calshot Activities Centre (Hampshire County Council owned). There will be 3 single days (Saturday or Sunday) leading to a residential weekend Fri – Sun, in March 2011.</p> <p>A variety of activities will be available – all land based due to the time of year the project is planned for. Many of the activities will be focused on team building and increasing self confidence and self esteem.</p> <p>Activities will be finalised after young people have taken part in a “taster” / consultation trip in September 2010. It is hoped that some of the young people will be able to focus on rock climbing and will have the opportunity to gain a nationally recognised award. This would provide a potential stepping stones for young people to continue the sport in the future.</p> <p>The exact costs of the project will not be known for some time. Young Carers are currently being identified who would benefit from this project. Once the young people are identified it may be necessary for adult services to complete care assessments and commission care packages as necessary for the family member the young person normally cares for.</p> <p>In many cases there may be another family member who can provide the care. However we do not wish to exclude a young person from the project if there is no one else who can care for their relative as these may be the most vulnerable young people.</p> <p>It is not know exactly how many young people will be able to attend. If 20 young people attend the activities will cost around £6,000 (quote from Calshot provided). Activities are based on 2 groups of 10. It may transpire that there will be more young people wishing to take part in the project and in this case the costs will increase . One</p>

	<p>community will work with young carers to identify the group in Autumn 2010 once the funding for the project has been secured.</p> <p>Transport will be provided by One Community Transport and 2 fully accessible minibuses with drivers will be hired for each event. Young Carers will be collected at point that are easy for them to get to. For the residential event one member of staff will take a car so that transport is also available in an emergency. Total cost will be £724.</p> <p>One Community will send 4 members of staff to accompany the young carers so there is a good ratio of staff to young people at all times. Total cost will be £2762.</p> <p>It may also be necessary, although unlikely, for one member of staff from youth services to attend and if this is necessary there will be staffing costs incurred.</p> <p>Adult services care- unknown at this stage but could be significant.</p> <p>Miscellaneous costs – rock climbing log books, cost of DVDs if one is produced at Calshot by the young people, presentation event at conclusion of project.</p> <p>The project is being arranged in partnership with Hampshire County Council , namely Calshot Activities Centre, Adult services, Children’s Services and the HAT officer.</p>
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<p>How does the Bid meet the HATs Term of Reference?</p> <p>1) To tackle economic, social and health inequalities in the local area</p> <p>2) To support the delivery of Hampshire’s improvement priorities within the Hampshire Local Area Agreement*</p> <p>3) To support local highways and transport priorities**</p>	<p>Young carers aged 11-16 living anywhere within Eastleigh Borough who are linked into One Community’s weekly young carers project would be able to participate in the project. These young people are a sector of society who are disadvantaged and face a number of inequalities.</p> <p>Working with this group of young people help address some of their inequalities and also supports LAA Theme A: Children and young people.</p>
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Timescale (What is the anticipated period over which the money will be spent?)	Commencement Date: Jan 2011 Completion Date: End March 2011
Intended Outcomes (How will the success of the bid/project be measured?)	Feedback will be sought from young people. A presentation event is being planned and it is hoped that HAT Members will be able to speak to the young people themselves about the project. There may be opportunities for young people to make a DVD about the project but this is subject to negotiations with Calshot and having gained appropriate consents.
Future Funding Arrangements (If the project is to last more than a year how will it be funded in subsequent years? How will any outcomes achieved by the project be sustained in the longer term? If it is a capital scheme how will the equipment be maintained?)	There is no future funding needed. Any under spend will be returned to the HAT community budget.
