1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1. To update members of the Policy & Resources Select Committee regarding the Review of the Severe Winter Weather experienced in Hampshire in 2009/10, initiated by this committee in January 2010.

- 2.1. Members of this committee formed a Review Panel that met between February and September 2010 to review the severe winter weather experienced in Hampshire in 2009/10.
