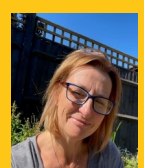

All construction courses are SWAPS and include a guaranteed interview opportunity

- ⇒ All courses offer a CSCS card (except \*S2C) and many have other add-ons; traffic marshal, MMC awareness, working at heights, abrasive wheels
- ⇒ \*S2C (Step Towards Construction course) is a construction focused employability course which introduces people to the construction industry as well as equipping them with transferable skills for any job.
