All courses are run as '**SWAPS**' and include a guaranteed interview opportunity

⇒ All planned courses offer a CSCS card and many have other add-ons; traffic marshal, MMC awareness, working at heights, abrasive wheels

⇒ **S2C** (Step Towards Construction course) is a construction focused employability course which introduces people to the construction industry as well as equipping them with transferable skills for any job—ask about this if you have people that might want insight into the sector before qualifying with CSCS or need a boost to their confidence in learning.
