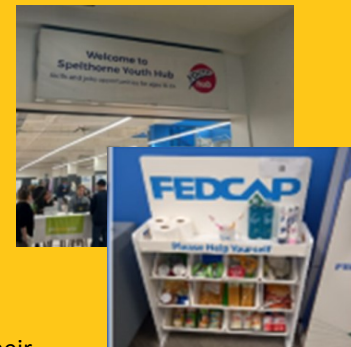

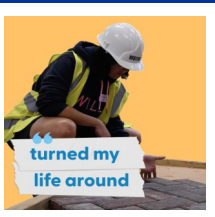
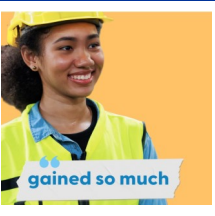
Our construction projects have helped 1200+ people from a wide range of backgrounds into work. At 4 training centres, the TCS supports unemployed people to gain skills, qualifications, confidence and access to work opportunities that change their lives and those of their families.

## Hampshire County Council's Technical Construction Skills project offers free training and opportunities for anyone unemployed and over 18.

All courses are run as '**SWAPS**' and include an interview opportunity

- ⇒ All courses offer a CSCS card and many have other add-ons, including: traffic marshal, MMC awareness, working at heights, abrasive wheels
- ⇒ Coordinators support candidates to attend courses and into employment after achieving the CSCS card + H&S Level 1 certificate
- ⇒ Several construction sites host the courses, enabling achievement of ESP KPIs
- ⇒ Access to a Job retention project is now active, supporting new starters to sustain work in the sector
