According to the Spring 2024 School Census, 6.2% of Hampshire's Black, Minority Ethnic and Traveller children were in Fareham schools (taken from the 'Ethnicity District' tab of the Demographic data booklet for Fareham, 2024). This equates to 2051 children, compared with 1844 (5.9%) in 2023 - a rise in the number of children and an increased percentage. Additionally, 5.6% of Hampshire's learners of EAL (English as an Additional Language) were in Fareham, which is equivalent to 1050 children (999, 5.7%, in the previous year, 2023).

Academic results for BME and Traveller groups are collected, analysed and reported on by Hampshire EMTAS annually. A summary analysis comparing the progress and attainment of BME and 'Hampshire All' is carried out in addition to more detailed analysis of progress and attainment of children in different ethnic groups. This data booklet shows the progress and attainment of children from BME and Traveller backgrounds in Fareham compared with the Hampshire All and National cohorts.

Within EMTAS, we recognise that different districts of Hampshire will have different needs according to their particular demographic.

All data that have been used are correct at the time of writing but may later be subject to minor changes as new data are published. Dates and sources are acknowledged. In some cases, numbers within ethnic groups are very small. To maintain confidentiality, values of 5 or less represented as <6.

Note that where numbers are small although there may be an indication of a particular pattern, it is very difficult to draw any firm conclusions and the data should be used with caution.

Summary by Ethnicity and Academic Year**

Results may be affected by when the child started school and their previous educational experience; in many countries children start school later than the UK so children who came as international new arrivals may have less school experience than other children. Further, some of the assessment work that is done in Foundation Stage must be performed in English and not the home language, which may skew results for children for whom English is an Additional Language (EAL). It is important that parents are encouraged to continue speaking their home language with their child as research tells us that pupils will develop stronger skills in English if they come to school with a solid foundation in their first language. EMTAS has produced a leaflet for parents/carers titled 'Bringing up your child in more than one language' that can be downloaded from the website in a range of languages. Also on the website is a leaflet for parents/carers that distinguishes the difference between home and first language.

Outcomes by ethnicity from the Year 1 phonics check show variability at County level with some groups eg 'mixed white and Asian', 'Bangladeshi' and 'Chinese' outperforming the 'white British' majority population and 'any other mixed', 'Asian other' and 'Asian Indian' coming very close. Other groups performed less well by this measure, the poorest being 'Gypsy/Roma'. The national picture differs in that outcomes for more of the ethnic groups shown were better than 'white British', though the poor outcomes for children in Traveller groups remains a constant. Note that the national data will be based on higher numbers of children than the Hampshire data.

The 2024 Key Stage 2 Hampshire outcomes by ethnicity again show variability. The groups that outperformed Hampshire's 'white British' cohort are 'white Irish', 'white other', 'mixed white and Asian, mixed other', 'Asian Indian', 'Asian Pakistani', 'Asian Bangladeshi', 'Asian other', 'black other' and 'Chinese'. The two Traveller groups, 'Gypsy/Roma' and 'Traveller of Irish heritage', were the ones with the poorest outcomes by this measure. Note that the ethnicity data are based on low numbers of pupils relative to the 'white British' figure.

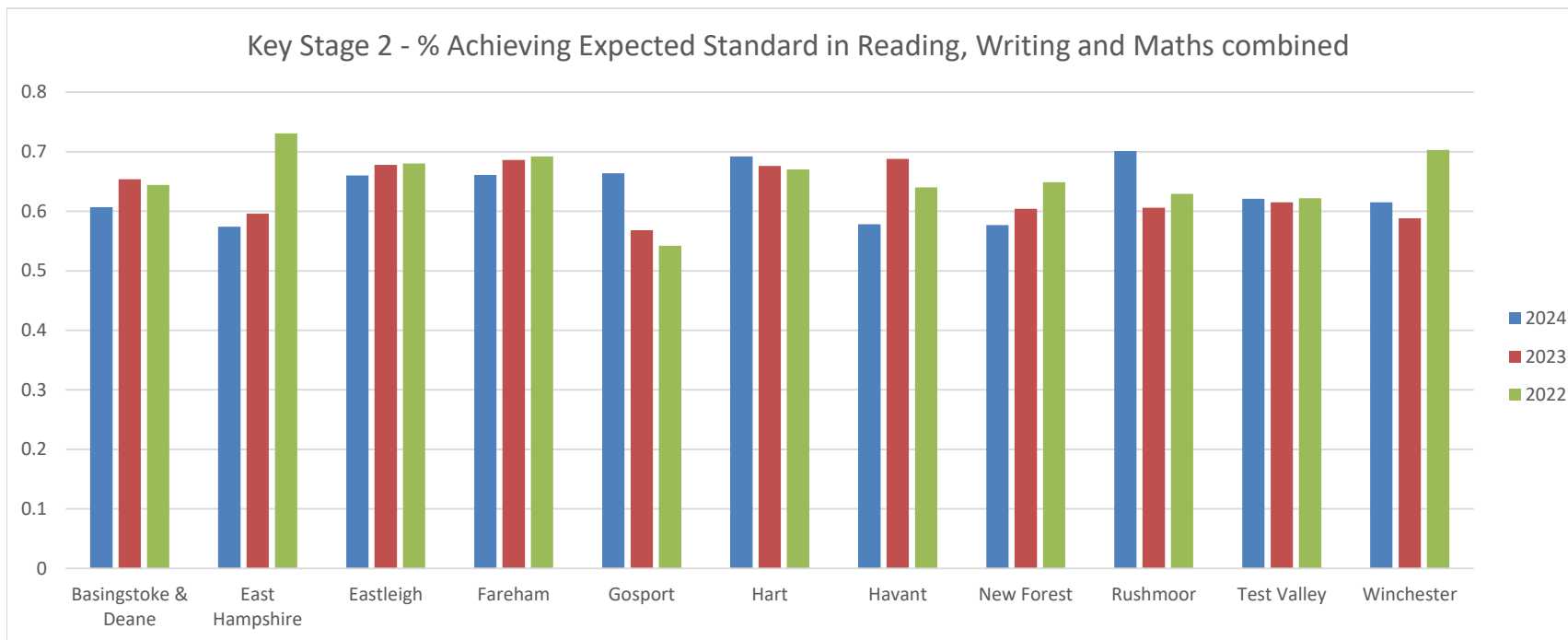

Summary by Ethnicity and Academic Year

Hampshire's Key Stage 4 outcomes by ethnicity show that most of the groups performed well in comparison with the white British majority school population. Those groups where this was not the case include the two Traveller groups ('Gypsy/Roma' and 'Traveller of Irish heritage') and children in various of the black groups. As with the other data included in this booklet, note that low numbers of children in the groups other than 'white British' mean these data should be treated with caution.

The Hampshire data below (middle table) show that by the end of Key Stage 4, pupils in most of the ethnic groups listed out-perform the 'White British' majority school population. However, a few pupil groups perform less well. 'Gypsy/Roma' and 'Traveller of Irish Heritage' are the two groups with the poorest outcomes, a trend that is sustained over the three years shown. Outcomes for Hampshire pupils in these groups are worse than the National. Poorer outcomes for pupils ascribed as 'Mixed White and Black Caribbean' and 'Mixed White and Black African' are also to be noted, though there is more variability here in comparison with the White British majority population. Note that numbers of pupils in the non-White British ethnic groups are low so the data should be treated with circumspection.
