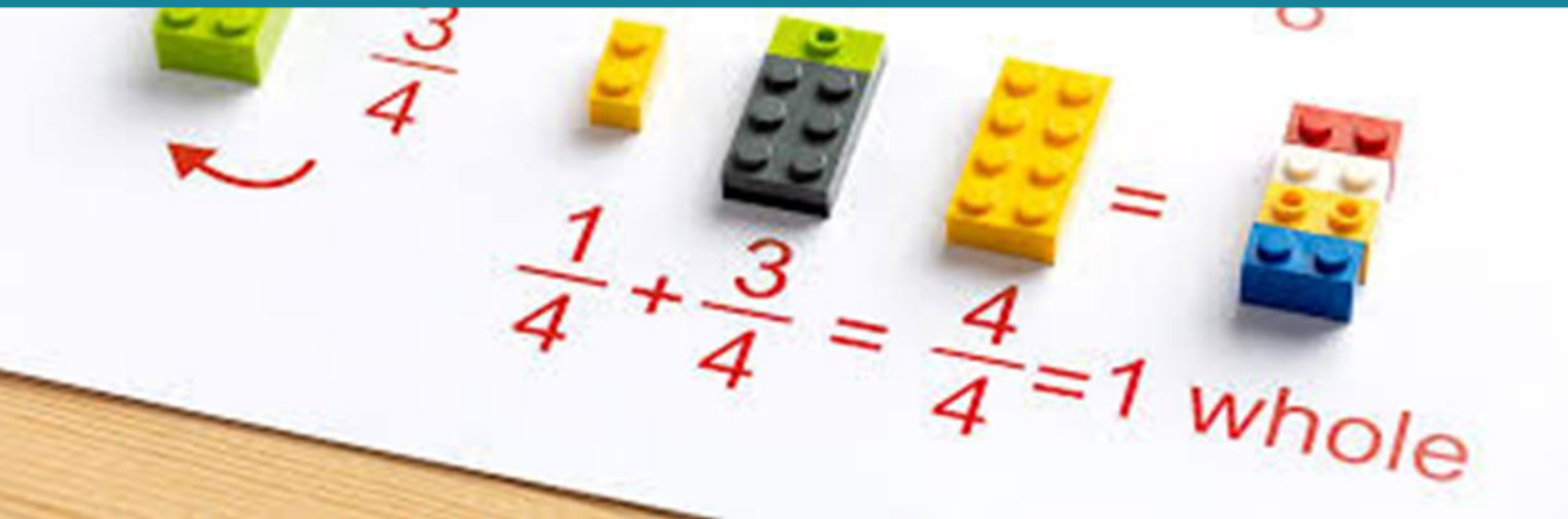

Upskill your Teaching Assistants to better support pupils in maths lessons

We provide a FREE one-day training course to recognise maths anxiety and help Teaching Assistants ensure they are providing the best possible support in the classroom.

A qualified primary teacher with a passion for maths will deliver the sessions which will;

- Explore the use of concrete and pictorial resources to support maths learning across KS1 and KS2
- Strengthen Teaching Assistant's understanding of scaffolding
- Identify what maths anxiety is, how to recognise it and how best to support anxieties in the classroom

At the end of the course, your school will be awarded Maths 'goodies' to help support learning in the classroom.

One day Teaching Assistant's Courses are open from 9.15am with a 9.30am start and will finish at 2.30pm. The session will include a half hour lunch break and a 10 minute break.

After this session, Teaching Assistants will have the opportunity to progress on to a second course where they are able to increase their personal maths skills with one-to-one support. This course will be available in or out of term time. This day will qualify attendees with a 'Maths Teaching Assistant Champion' status, and they will receive more resources to utilise within your classrooms.
