### Get involved in planning!

The Central and Eastern Berkshire Authorities (Bracknell Forest Council, Reading Borough Council, The Royal Borough of Windsor & Maidenhead and Wokingham Borough Council) are working in partnership to produce a Joint Minerals and Waste Plan which will guide minerals and waste decision making in the Plan area up until 2036.

The first stage in plan-preparation is known as the 'Issues and Options' Consultation. The purpose of this consultation is to engage the community in discussion on the **ISSUES** for managing minerals and waste for the next 20 years. It is also an opportunity to gather more evidence to inform the **OPTIONS** for the plan policies and site allocations.
