Dear Sir/Madam,

Please find below Eversley Parish Council's response to the Joint minerals and Waste Plan consultation:

Main Modification to Policy M3 proposes a new paragraph as "clarification on reliance on imports during the Plan period based on allocations." However, it does not state which other Mineral Authorities will be expected to have to overproduce to make up for Central and Eastern Berkshire's shortfall. Furthermore, it states that that shortfall will be both increasing and increasing more rapidly over the next 14 years. Hampshire is likely to be one of the Mineral Authorities which will be expected to make up some of the shortfall. Therefore, the village of Eversley is going to be subjected to further excessive HGV traffic due to Central and Eastern Berkshire's failure to Plan to meet its own demands for sand and gravel. Eversley Parish Council objects to the planned shortfall and to the Main Modification on behalf of all its residents whose quality of life will be adversely affected by the impacts of traffic due to the Joint Minerals and Waste Plan.
