Description of current service/policy

The County Council currently commissions Dial-a-Ride, Call and Go and Minibus Group Hire Schemes across Hampshire. Most contracts are due for renewal on 1 April 2019.

Geographical impact: All

Description of proposed change

This report seeks approval for a procurement process which will commission the next generation of community transport contracts for implementation on 1 April 2019. It sets out the overall approach for commissioning these services which is consistent with the current Community Transport Operating Model approved by the Executive Member for Environment and Transport at a decision day on 23 March 2017. Contracts will be extended for two years with an option to extend for a further four years. The report also recommends a review of fare structures at Dial-a-Ride and Call and Go schemes across Hampshire. The funding available to provide services will remain the same.
