### Description of current service/policy

Transport for the South East appointed consultants Steer and WSP to help develop its Transport Strategy alongside TfSE's sixteen constituent Local Transport Authorities and the region's five Local Enterprise Partnerships. A number of wider organisations have also participated in the development of the strategy through the TfSE Transport Forum and numerous stakeholder workshops, including the region's forty-six district and borough councils, bus and rail operators, and infrastructure providers such as Highways England, Network Rail, ports and airports. TfSE is currently consulting on its draft strategy with a deadline for responses of 10th January 2020.

The County Council has been granted a short extension to tie in with the Executive Member Decision process which will enable the County Council's response to obtain Executive Member approval. The Transport Strategy, Integrated Sustainability Appraisal, and supporting evidence are being made available to the public and all consultees along with a consultation questionnaire.
