Description of current service/policy

Glass collected from Hampshire households via the district councils or Household Waste Recycling Centres is delivered to designated delivery points across the county. From these points, the glass is handled under a contract with Veolia, who are responsible for collecting the glass from these locations and sending it for reprocessing. This contract expired in 2018, and approval is being sought from the ETE Executive Member to bring the service into the main waste disposal service contract.

The service specification will not fundamentally change. The contract only applies to glass once it has been collected from residents, and there will be no change to services provided to the public. All administrative arrangements will remain the same, the only change will be that the contract will run until 31 December 2030.
