The Flood Risk Regulations require all Lead Local flood Authorities to prepare and adopt a Preliminary Flood Risk Assessment (PFRA). A PFRA is a high level summary of significant local flood risk i.e. flooding from surface run-off, groundwater and ordinary watercourses. Hampshire's PFRA was adopted in 2011. The regulations require a 6 yearly review, a process that commenced in 2017 with the current review of all PFRAs. Geographical impact* All Hampshire
