## Level 2 Community Sexual Health and Influenza Immunisation Services

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Department: Adults' Health and Care  
Date of assessment: 10/09/2018

### Description of current service/policy

The current Approved List of Public Health services expires on 31 March 2019. A review of services has been completed by the Public Health team and it has identified an ongoing need to commission the Long Acting Reversible Contraception service, the Emergency Hormonal Contraception service and the Influenza Immunisation service. Approval is sought from the Executive Member for Public Health to spend in relation to these services, up to a maximum value of £13,898,500 from 1 April 2019 with a maximum contract term of 7 years.

### Description of proposed change

The proposal is to recommission the above services from April 2019 by way of an Open Framework. These services are required to be delivered at scale across a range of qualified, clinical providers, ensuring that the County Council has sufficient geographical coverage across Hampshire, to deliver improved public health outcomes for Hampshire residents. There are no proposed changes to the eligibility criteria to provide these services. Qualified providers will need to apply to the County Council to join the open framework to provide these services from the 1st April 2019.

information on the services and the framework application process. The opportunity to join the framework will be advertised to potential providers on the County Council's procurement portal and in the Official Journal of the European Union (OJEU).
