



## Project Appraisal: Brighton Hill Roundabout and Camrose Link Road Basingstoke

### Description of current service/policy

The Camrose Link Road is an advanced component of the wider Brighton Hill Roundabout scheme. Authority is being sought to deliver the Camrose Link Road Scheme, which will unlock land for business and residential developments on the Camrose site and will advantage the operation of Brighton Hill roundabout. The new link also provides for a diversion route to help manage traffic during the roundabout construction.

### Description of proposed change

To undertake advanced construction works at the A30 Brighton Hill Roundabout in Basingstoke during spring 2020 ahead of the main contract award. Advanced works will include utility diversions, part site clearance of trees and vegetation bounding the northern side of Brighton Hill Community School and localised relocation of street furniture to allow for utility diversions. Construction of new Camrose Link Road proposal to provide a new 240m long, single carriageway road between the A30 Winchester Road and Western Way.

### Engagement and consultation

The previous consultation exercise is detailed within the Executive Member for Economy, Transport and Environment on 13 November 2018: Basingstoke South West Corridor to Growth – Brighton Hill Roundabout report. During development of the scheme, and having undertaken further on-site investigations, it became apparent that extending the existing subways and ramps would prove technically challenging and would add in excess of £7million to the cost. An online public consultation to assess views for removing the subways took place between 20 May & the end of July. The feedback from the consultation is currently being collated and an update will be reported to the Executive Member in the Autumn.
