

Equality Impact Assessment

What is an Equality Impact Assessment (EIA) and why does the County Council do them?

The [Public Sector Equality Duty](#) (PSED) is an obligation within the [Equality Act 2010](#) (“the Act”), which asks public authorities, like Hampshire County Council, to give ‘due regard’ to equality considerations, in particular to:

- Eliminate unlawful discrimination, harassment and victimisation and other conduct prohibited by the Act.
- Advance equality of opportunity between people who share a protected characteristic and those who do not.
- Foster good relations between people who share a protected characteristic and those who do not.

This includes assessing the impact of policies and practices on individuals and communities with a protected characteristic, as defined in the Act and some other specific groups. The County Council uses EIAs to ensure it has paid ‘due regard’ to equalities considerations when there are changes to a service or policy, a new project or certain decisions.

Service affected	Highways - Designing and delivering larger planned maintenance schemes on the highway network, such as carriageway resurfacing and surface treatments, footway reconstruction and structural drainage repairs.
Description of the service/policy/project/project phase	Planned Maintenance delivers Highway Maintenance Schemes, working within the Capital Implementation team but funded and instructed via Highways Commissioning.
New/changed service/policy/project	The current fee level taken from funding to cover design and supervision of works is 15%. The proposal is to raise the fee level on Planned Maintenance drainage design and supervision from 15% to 25%.
