The Purpose

1. To provide HPPB with an overview of emerging findings from the Infrastructure Gap and Opportunity Analysis, and ask HPPB for feedback. The emerging findings will be presented at the meeting by Jacobs, who are carrying out this study.

Background

2. The Infrastructure Gap and Opportunity Analysis is one of the priority workstreams agreed by HPPB in March. It aims to identify constraints on economic growth, and priorities for investment, in the following three areas:
 - transport infrastructure
 - digital infrastructure
 - business space

6. This report will inform a subsequent discussion with HPPB about how to advocate for investment into infrastructure priorities. It will also feed into work to develop the evidence base for a Local Growth Plan for Hampshire and the Solent.
