GEOLOGY Bagshot Sands with Bracklesham Beds to the S.

SITE CONTEXT The Victorian church stands on a slight ridge at a little over 35m OD. To the NE the land rises to a small hill at 52m OD. The settlement lies to the S of the church at between 25 and 30m OD in the valley of a small stream.

PLAN TYPE & DESCRIPTION Linked farmsteads. The late C19 picture of the settlement shows a couple of farms and cottages along a lane which terminates near one of the farms. The church is positioned away from the farms to the N lying near the main NE-SW road.

The settlement pattern over the general area is one of farmsteads and scattered cottages with short irregular rows at Winsor where settlement appears to have been encroachment on a narrow neck of land surrounded on three sides by a detached portion of Thorngate. Whether the settlement was taking advantage of an area of land which was of uncertain tenure or that the boundary was respecting the settlement is not known.

Newbridge, to the NW of Copythorne is an irregular row along a N-S road which appears to be the most substantial settlement in the area.

AREAS OF ARCHAEOLOGICAL POTENTIAL A small AAP covers the area of the two farms on the SE side of Vicarage Lane. Information regarding the development of these farms will help in the understanding of the development of the dispersed settlement pattern of the area, especially if it can be added to with similar information from other early farms of the district.

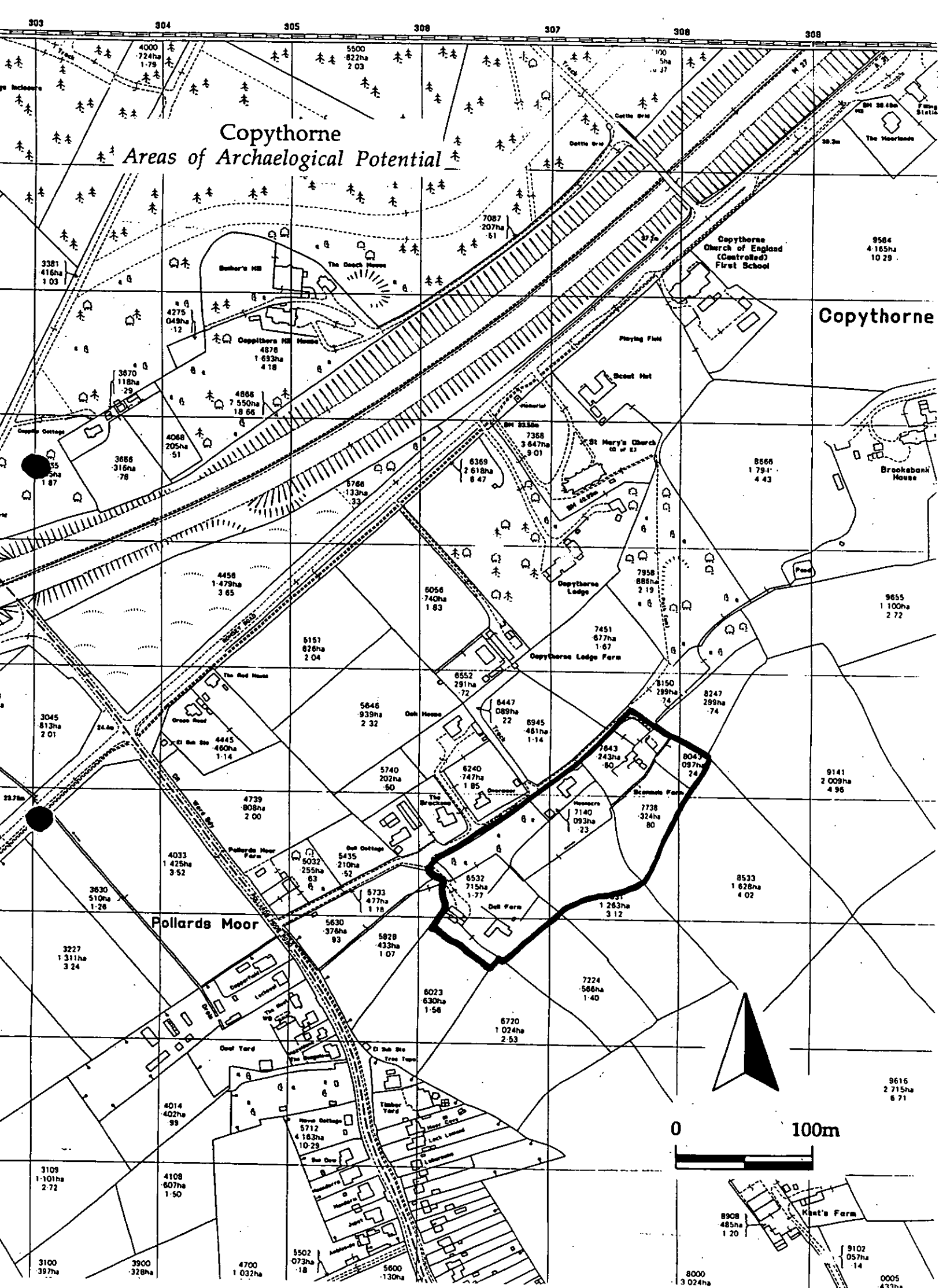
