PRIMARY HISTORIC SOURCES

Domesday Agemund. He himself held it from King Edward in freehold. Then and now it paid tax for 5 hides. Land for 3 pl. In lordship 1 pl; 10 smallholders with 2 pl. 2 mills at 100d; meadow, 12 acres; woodland at 6 pigs. The value was 60s; now 40s. Waleran took away 1.5 virgates of this manor and put them outside the County, in Wiltshire. 3 virgates of this land are in the King's Forest.

Waleran holds 1.5 virgates in OUTWICK and Jocelyn from him. Agemund held it from King Edward in freehold. It belonged to Wellow, so the Hundred and Shire state. Land for 0.5 pl. It is there with 1 villager and 1 smallholder. Meadow, 3 acres; a little woodland. The value was 10s; now 5s.

Embley was taxed at 6s in 1334 but was not listed separately in 1524.

Manorial Documents Manors of East Wellow, Embley, West Wellow and Dunwood, an extra-parochial area which formed part of the royal forest.

PLACE NAME 873x888 *welwe*. This seems to be an old name for the river Blackwater and may be the *Velox* recorded in the 6C *Ravenna Cosmography*. Origin uncertain.

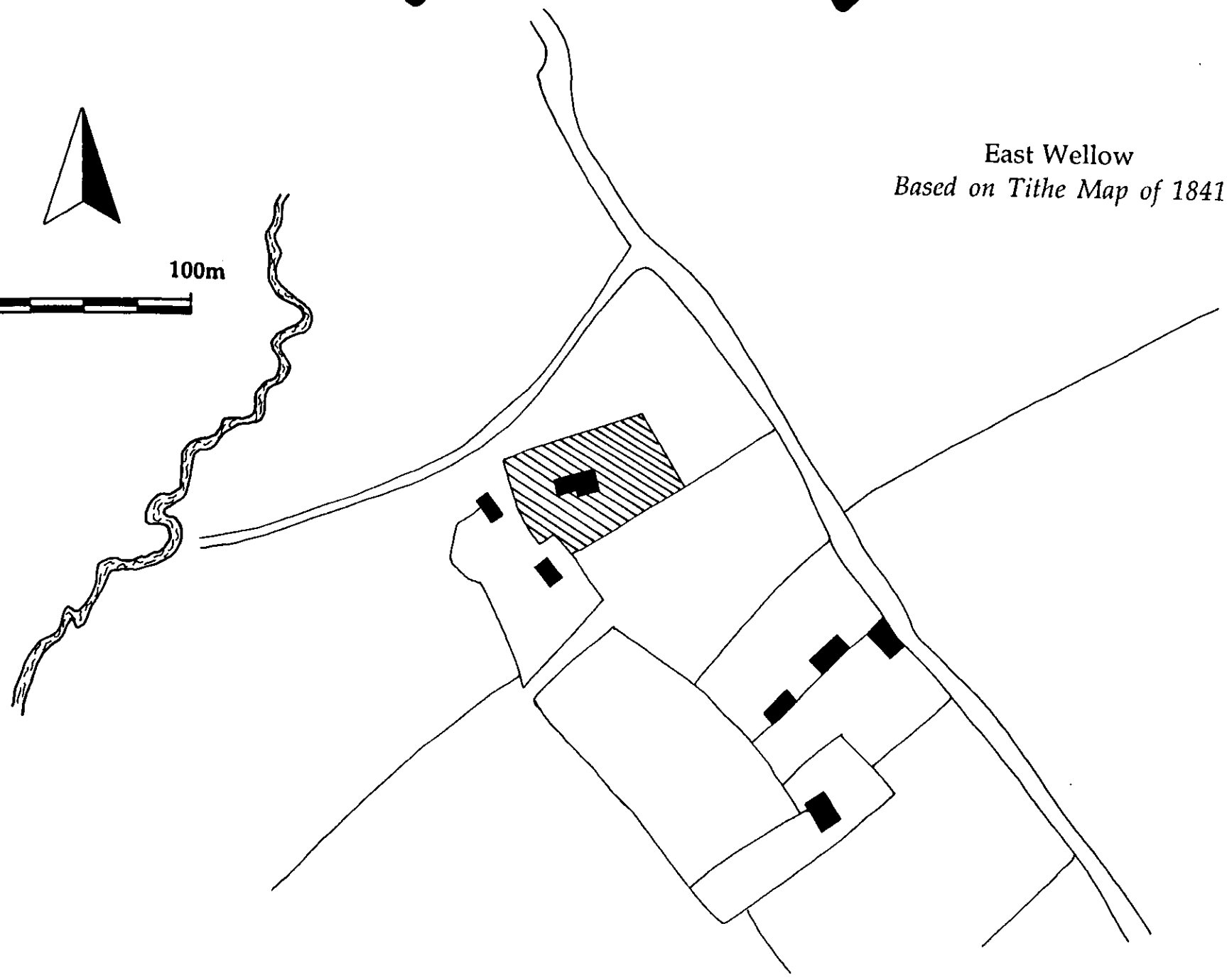
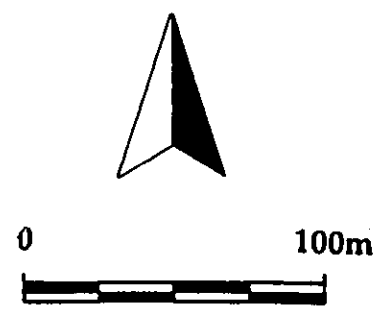
