

NAME Goodworth Clatford  
PARISH Goodworth Clatford  
HUNDRED Wherwell  
DISTRICT Test Valley  
NGR SU 362423  
GEOLOGY Upper chalk, river gravels and alluvium to east

SITE CONTEXT The main area of settlement lies on the W bank of the River Test along the line of the valley at around 50m OD. The church is sited on the E bank of the river at about 55m OD. On both sides of the river the land rises steadily to over 80m OD.

PLAN TYPE & DESCRIPTION Polyfocal. Irregular row, Church/Manor Farm and short irregular row.

The main road through the settlement runs long the W side of the River Test and is approximately parallel to it. On the E side of the street around the junction with the lane to the E there is an irregular row with properties running back to the river. There is a large gap midway in the row but the pattern is continued further to the N. To the S the boundaries run at angles to the road. The Tithe map shows the lines of the boundaries dotted on the E side of the canal (the W water course) showing that the river formed the rear boundary for these plots before the construction of the canal. It is possible that the irregular row shown on the C19 map is the remains of a once regular row. On the W side of the street there is almost continual occupation along the length of the village but the plots are irregular in size although they are mainly square or oblong. There is no common rear boundary.

The church is positioned away from the village on the E side of the river with the Manor Farm. S of the church in the C19 was a large house, now demolished.

Alongside the river on the E side, is a small area of settlement along a lane which fades out into a track. The plots in this area are of irregular shape or almost square and are all quite small. The road to the church appears to cut diagonally across a square field.

The 1665 Hearth Tax records two settlements, Goodworth and Clatford (Upper Clatford is also recorded) and so presumably these represent the two areas of settlement on either side of the river. However, the C19 map certainly suggests that the settlement on the W side of the river was the largest but the Hearth Tax records two settlements of almost equal size.

#### AREAS OF ARCHAEOLOGICAL POTENTIAL

The rows on both sides of the main street through the village are covered by an AHAP. The area behind the row on the W side is an AAP. Although this row does not appear to have any regularity, there is a possibility that evidence of land division will survive in this area.

The church/Manor Farm centre is the focus for a second AHAP with an AAP stretching down slope from the church to the river to include the small area of settlement on the E bank of the river.

CHURCH & CHURCHYARD St Peter. Norman part of S arcade c.1190. Evidence of a transept arch of probably the same time as S arcade. Part of S arcade C13. N arcade later. W respond and E arch C14 decoration.

The churchyard shown on the Tithe map was almost square but has been extended to form an irregular quadrangle.

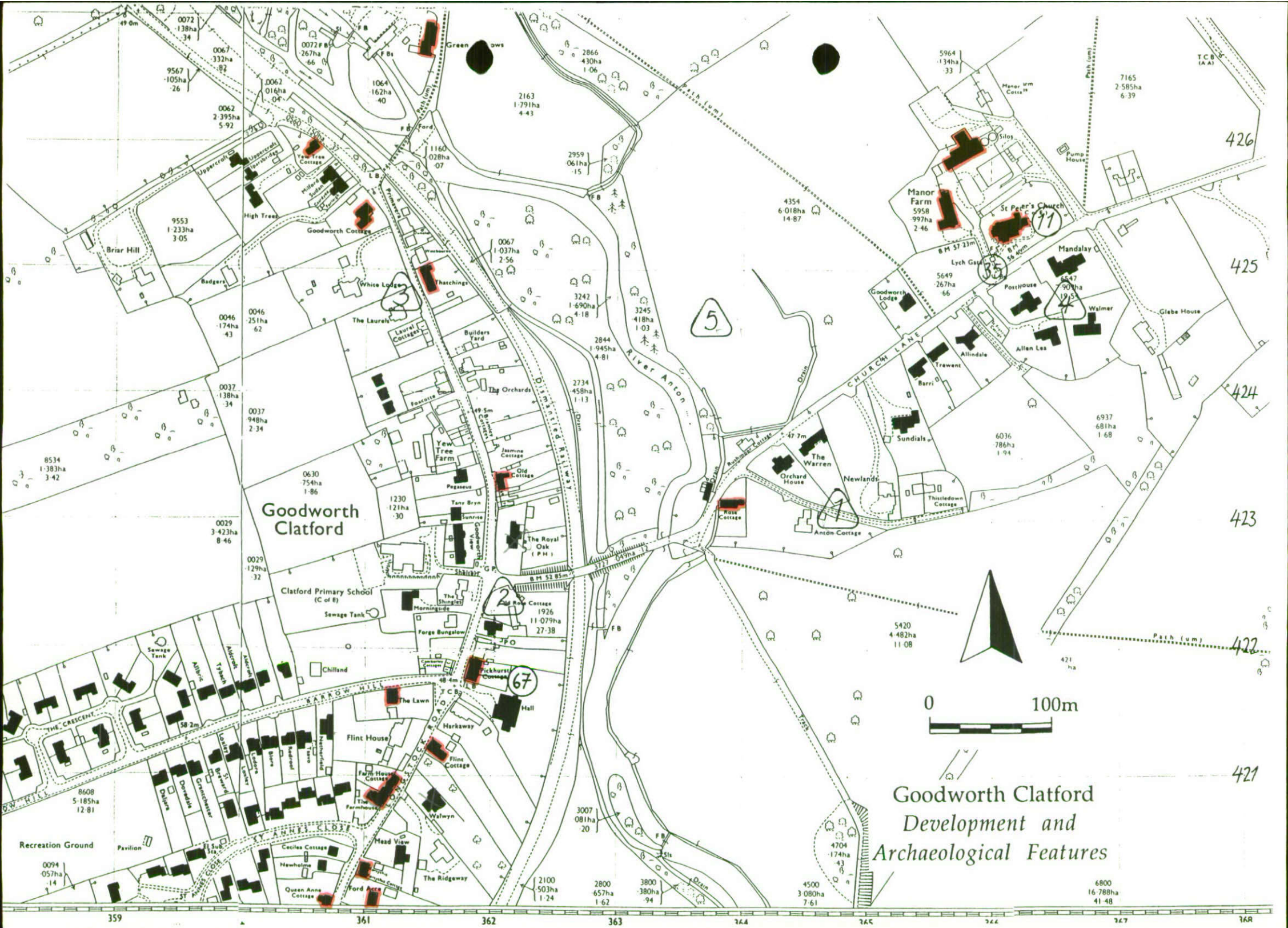

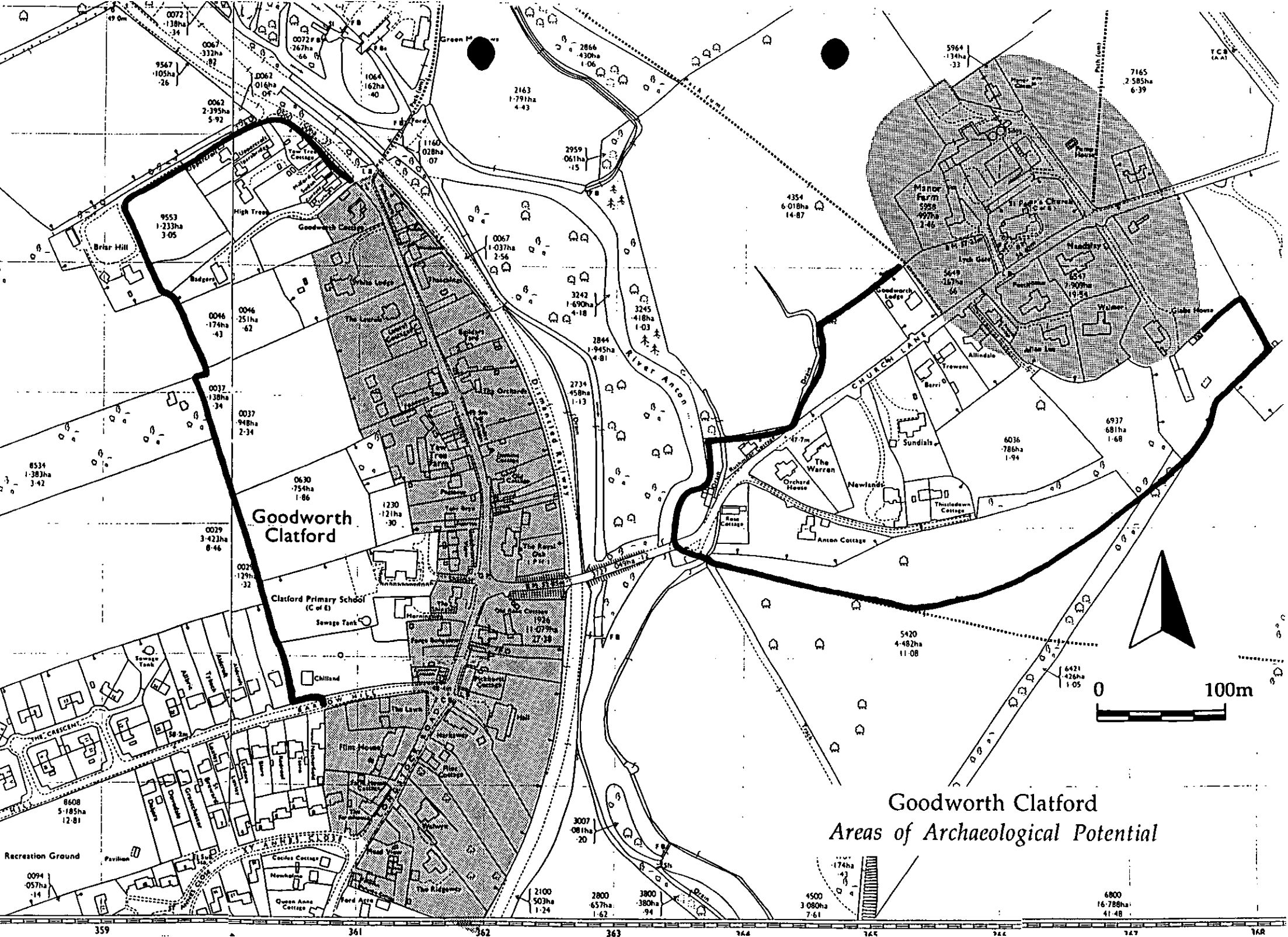


Goodworth Clatford
