**SITE CONTEXT** The church/manor centre lie at 70m OD on a gentle E facing slope. To the E the land rises to a little over 80m OD while to the W the land falls slightly to the wide flood plain of the River Loddon.

**PLAN TYPE & DESCRIPTION** Manor and church complex with an irregular row on common edge.

Along the N and E edge of the common are three blocks of properties all with narrow plots lying along the edge of the common. To the the W of the manor is a single cottage with outbuildings.

#### AREAS OF ARCHAEOLOGICAL POTENTIAL

The area around the church and Court, including the moated site and the ponds to the E, is an AHAP. This area also includes the field to the N of the church where there are some slight earthworks and the area around the 'dog-leg' in the road where any early settlement clustering around the road may have been.

To the S of the AHAP, the AAP includes the fields to the S of the farm and church to cover the possibility that there were ancilliary buildings around the Court and perhaps settlement. Also within the AAP is the area of the common edge settlement shown on the Tithe map.

##### PRIMARY HISTORIC SOURCES

**Domesday** Aubrey the Chamberlain. Ælfric held it from King Edward in freehold. Then and now it paid tax for 1.5 hides. Land for. . . 4 villagers with 3 pl; 1 slave. A mill at 3s; meadow, 6 acres; woodland at 5 pigs. Value before 1066, later, and now 40s; however, it pays 45s.

Ælfric. Alric held it from King Edward in freehold. Then it paid tax for 1 hide. Land for 2 pl. 5 villagers with 2 pl. meadow, 6 acres; woodland at 4 pigs. The value was and is 15s. The holder of this land states that he bought it from earl William for 2 marks of gold, but had never had it before.

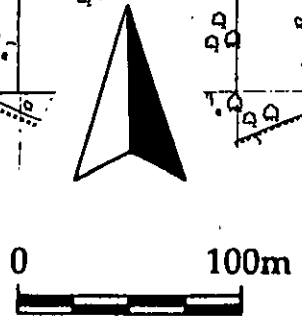
