Main Modification 4 comments	Policy 1 is now firmly tied in with NPPF and the sustainable development principle via planning applications and assessments. The removal of the sentence relating to adverse effects versus benefits removes subjectivity. The removal of the sentence relating to NPPF indications that development should be refused additionally points to a swifter route to sustainable development. The policy is sound.t
Main Modification 5 comments	Achieving carbon neutrality at the latest by 2025 acknowledges the HCC and Government target allows for the possibility of earlier achievement. Climate Change Assessments will demonstrate how the target will be tackled through planning applications. The removal of the reduction of greenhouse gases where possible implies a more positive approach and aim to remove them. The policy now shows a focussed attitude to global warming and is therefore sound.
Main Modification 15 comments	The wording as amended tightens up the prevention of sterilisation by non-mineral development. This is important to preserve resources. The policy is sound.
Main Modification 17 comments	For greater resilience, it is necessary to preserve a good level of aggregate supply after the decline in availability during the Covid period of at least 0.90 mtpa and at least 0.16 mtpa of soft sand to 2040. This is sound practice and policy.
Main Modification 22 comments	3) relates to Micheldever Sidings which are safeguarded as a potential rail depot in Policy 34. In our Regulation 19 response, we drew attention to the planning constraints of this site. We understand that it is otherwise a suitable option, but given the provisions of the amended plan, we hope these issues will be properly assessed at the planning application stage.
