Lorries bring in material are often not taking material back out, and empty vehicles sometimes cause greater vibration/noise than full ones. The very nature of 'transfer' often includes very large vehicles taking compacted material away from the site. |
| Main Modification 30 comments | Policy 29, para 6.155 In my experience, CLU's have often been given based on historical evidence- often with much smaller HGV's. New operations -or expanding ones have vehicle movements agreed on these CLU figures but new vehicles are so much larger.
