Family Carer Permit - Terms and Conditions

A Family Carer permit is available to relatives who provide care duties to a resident of a permit road.

Permits will be valid for a period of 3 months from the date of issue.

Permits are at no cost.

The permit must be cancelled if no longer required. The council has the right to withdraw entitlement to a permit or cancel a permit for misuse.

The permit is only valid in 'Permit Holder Only' or 'shared use' parking bays.

The Council cannot guarantee a parking space will always be available to use.

The family member will need to upload proof of residency of the person requiring care (e.g., council tax bill or utility bill) and proof of vehicle registration (e.g., V5C) before a permit is issued. The permit application will be rejected if insufficient evidence is supplied.

The permit will only be valid for 3 hours in the zone applicable to the resident address of the person requiring care.

If applicant also lives within the same resident permit zone, this cannot be used as an alternative to a resident permit.

The maximum entitlement is 3 family carer permits in issue at any one time for the resident address.

If you fail to comply with any of the parking regulations, you may receive a Penalty Charge Notice.
