Health Care Permits- Terms and Conditions

The Healthcare permit is available to employees of organisations that provide health or social care visits to residents of permit roads in the community.

Permits will be valid for a period of 12 months from the date of issue.

The permit will be valid in the district/borough selected in the application.

Vehicles can only be parked in the residents' zone for a maximum of 3 hours.

Permits are at no cost.

The permit must be cancelled if no longer required or the employee leaves the organisation.

The permit must only be used when carrying out work duties. The council has the right to withdraw entitlement to a permit or cancel a permit for misuse.

If the permit holder resides in a residents' permit zone, the permit cannot be used as an alternative to a residents' permit to increase eligibility.

The permit is only valid in 'Permit Holder Only' or 'shared use' parking bays.

The Council cannot guarantee a parking space will always be available to use.

The employee is required to upload proof of employment and proof of vehicle registration (e.g., V5C) before a permit is issued. The permit application will be rejected if insufficient evidence is supplied.

If you fail to comply with any of the parking regulations, you may receive a Penalty Charge Notice.
