Annual Parking Report 2024/25

Introduction

Hampshire County Council carries out 'On Street' parking enforcement in Hampshire using a third-party contractor and, as the Enforcement Authority for on-street car parking, is required to publish a breakdown of income and expenditure on the authority's parking account. The breakdown of income must include details of revenue collected from on-street parking, off-street parking, Penalty Charge Notices and how the authority has spent any surplus on its parking account.

Hampshire County Council runs one 'Off Street' car park in Winchester (Durngate Car Park) which is operated under a 'Pay and Display' charging system. Hampshire County Council also operates on-street 'Pay and Display' parking at several locations across the County.
