**1. Executive Summary**

- 1.1. Section 12 of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 requires Police and Crime Commissioners to publish an annual report on the exercise of their functions in each financial year, details progress made in the financial year towards the achievement of the priorities in the Police and Crime Plan.
- 1.2. The Annual Report for 2015/16 is presented to the Police and Crime Plan for it to respond and make any recommendations as appropriate.

**2. Contextual Information**

- 2.1. Production of an annual report is a legislative requirement at the end of each financial year. It is presented in draft form to the Police and Crime Panel for comment and recommendation, prior to formal publication.
- 2.2. This annual report is unusual in that the current Police and Crime Commissioner, Michael Lane, is required to report to the panel and publish an annual report on work carried out during 2015/16 when Simon Hayes was Police and Crime Commissioner.
- 2.3. This report has therefore been produced by the officers of the Police and Crime Commissioner to meet the statutory requirements of the office holder, providing a factual account of activities against the priorities in place during the defined period of time.

**3. Recommendations**

- 3.1 Members of the Police and Crime Panel are asked to comment on the attached annual report prior to its formal publication.
- 3.2 During a PCC election year, the Panel agree to receive the Annual Report at their March meeting rather than their July meeting.
