Central and Eastern Berkshire Authorities Joint Minerals and Waste Issues and Options Consultation

Thank you for consulting Buckinghamshire County Council (BCC), we welcome the opportunity to comment on the issues and option consultation for the Central and Eastern Berkshire Authorities.

We are in support of the proposed Vision, Strategic Objective and Spatial Strategy proposed for the plan, along with the planned approaches around identifying mineral provision and waste management requirements for the authorities.

BCC would like to note that aggregate movement between ourselves and Slough has occurred in the past, and whilst the majority has probably occurred between Slough and the Eastern and Central Authorities, these movements cannot be ruled out for meeting Slough's future need.

BCC believes that the Colnbrook Energy from Waste facility is a vital strategic waste management facility for Central and Eastern Berkshire and Slough and therefore a replacement will need to be identified to meet the capacity which will be lost.

Thank you for providing us with the opportunity to comment on the plan and we look forward to further engagement with yourselves during the planning process.
