Dear Hampshire Services

Thank you for consulting Hampshire County Council's Planning Policy Team on the Central and Eastern Berkshire Joint Minerals and Waste Plan: Issues and Options Consultation.

Hampshire County Council recognise that both minerals and waste are not restricted to single counties and frequently travel across boundaries. Should the Central and Eastern Berkshire Authorities require further information on minerals and waste movements, Hampshire County Council will respond accordingly to any Duty to Cooperate requests.

Hampshire County Council also supports the principles of net self sufficiency in the areas of minerals and waste provision (as set out in the vision for Central and Eastern Berkshire), with the expectation that each planning authority does their best to meet their own needs, whilst also giving consideration to regional and national movements and requirements.

Hampshire County Council is also a member of SEWPAG and SEEAWP, as are the Central and Eastern Berkshire Authorities. These regional boards also help to steer and provide direction for the authorities, particularly when making bigger decisions.

We would agree with the use of the Environment Agency's (EA) Waste Data Interrogator (WDI) to produce the figures for the waste section of the paper, and the annual monitoring reports that have fed the minerals data.
