## Population

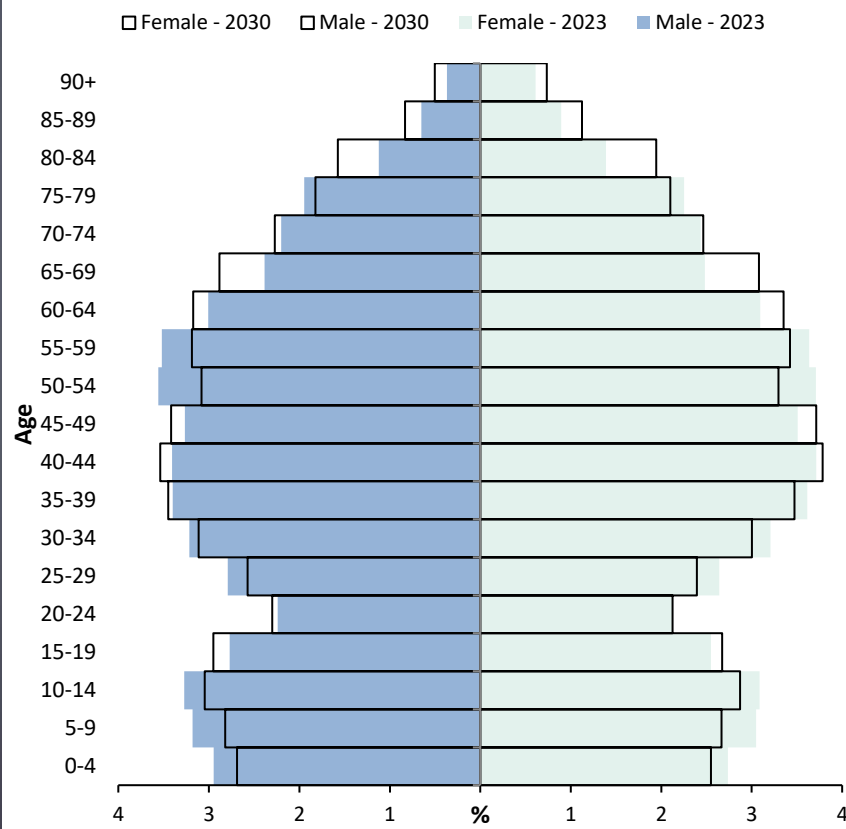
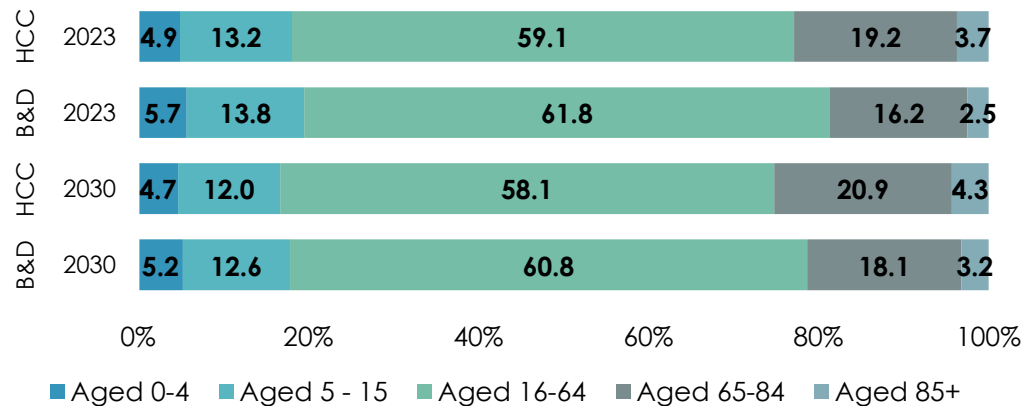
The Population of Basingstoke and Deane is forecast to increase from **187,900** to **197,300** by 2030. This is a forecast population increase of **9,400**. An increase of **5.0%**

## Dwellings

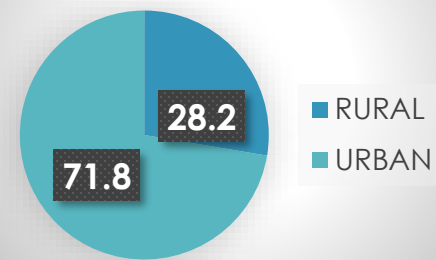
There is forecast to be a **7.3%** increase (or **5,900** additional dwellings) by 2030, up from **80,520** dwellings in 2023.
