Population

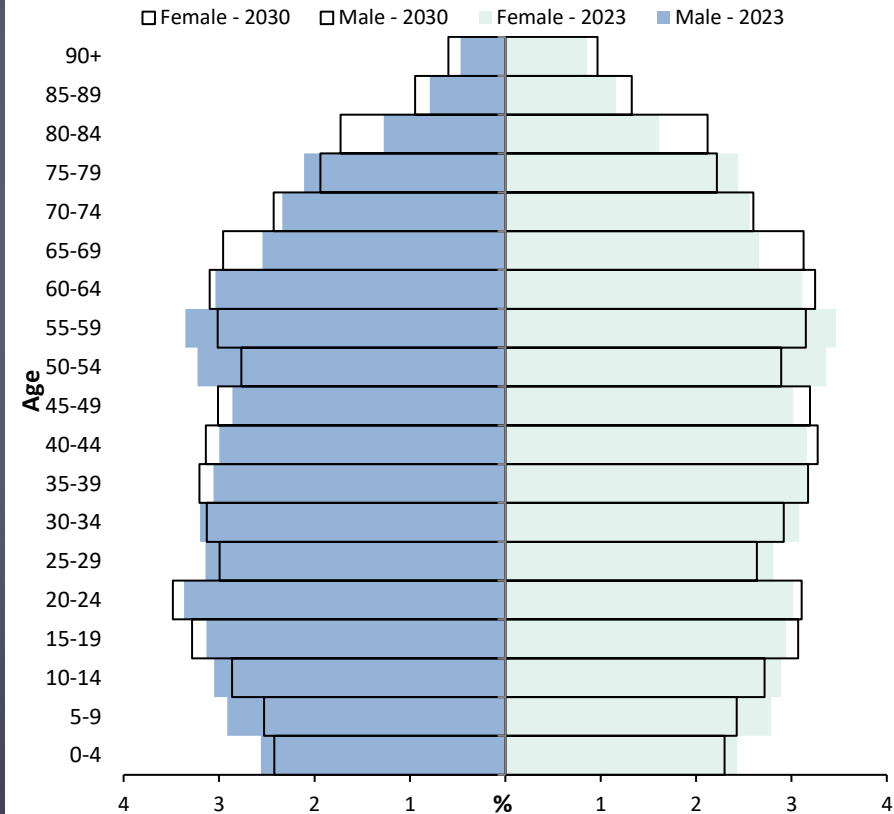
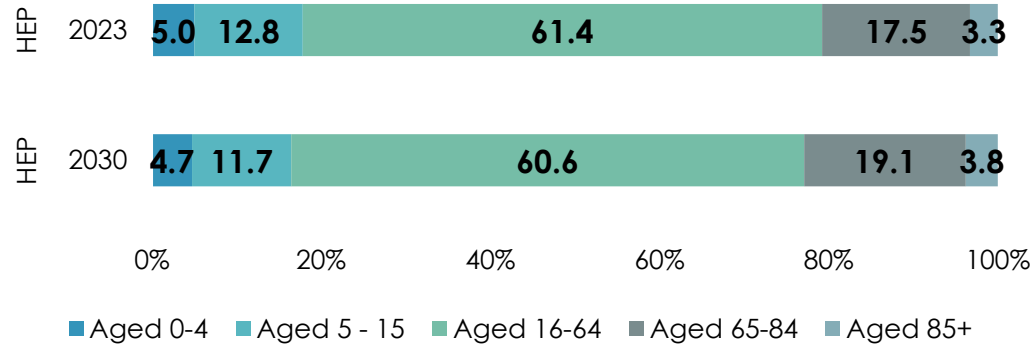
The Population of Hampshire HEP is forecast to increase from **1,917,500** to **2,018,600** by 2030. This is a forecast population increase of **101,100**. An increase of **5.3%**

Dwellings

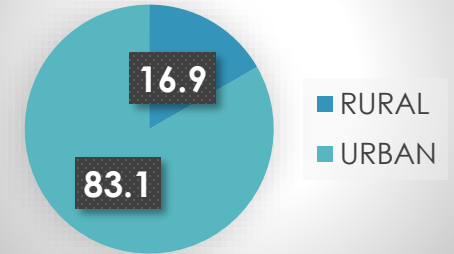
There is forecast to be a **6.5%** increase (or **54,030** additional dwellings) by 2030, up from **827,540** dwellings in 2023.
