The Population of Portsmouth is forecast to increase from **214,100** to **222,300** by 2030. This is a forecast population increase of **8,200**.

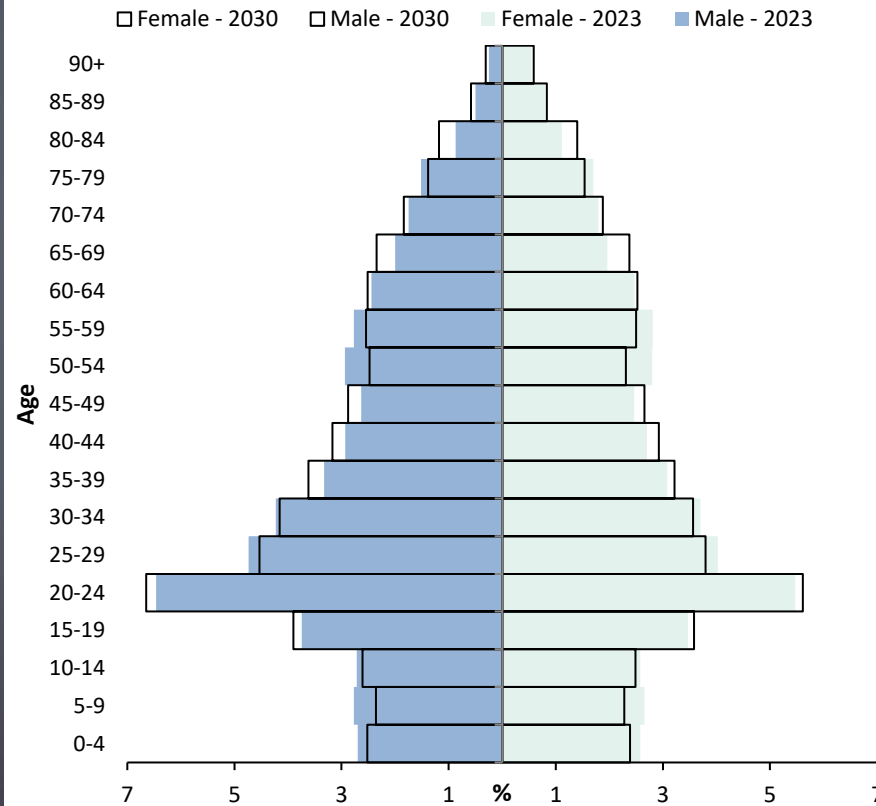
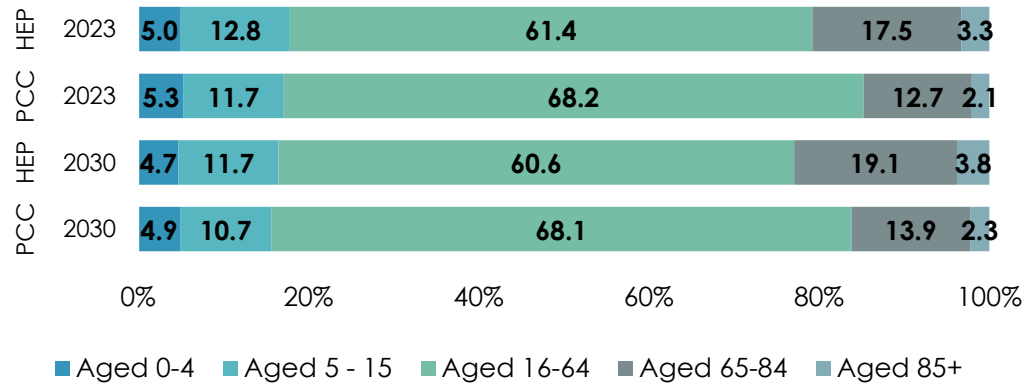
An increase of **3.8%**
