Beauworth 2	Footpath	5787 2612 Junction with Footpath 1	5817 2601 Junction with Kilmeston Footpath 4, at Parish Boundary	<u>From No. 1 east of Beauworth Farm to Parish Boundary</u> From No. 1 through wicket gate, south eastwards across pasture, over wire fence, then across arable field and over slip rails at Parish Boundary.
Beauworth 3	Restricted Byway	5739 2599 Road U177, Westfield Drove, west of Park Cottage	5645 2554 Road U177, Holden Lane	<u>From U.177 west of St. James's Church to Junction with Road U.177, Holding Lane Westfield Drove</u> From U.177 south westwards along 10ft. wide gravel road enclosed approximately 20ft. wide between hedges to junction with Road U.177.
Beauworth 4	Footpath	5644 2554 Road U177, Holden Lane	5622 2559 Junction with Cheriton Footpath 16, at Parish Boundary	<u>From Road U.177, Holding Lane, to Parish Boundary</u> From U.177 through gateway westwards across arable field, and over stile at Parish Boundary.
