This 166 metre long, 10ft wide track (FP7106a) is contiguous with the bridleway connecting to it. Once the upgrade takes place, it will provide a direct means to gain access from the centre of Hannington to the bridleway and bicycle network beyond.

Work has been completed to improve the track during 2017, the resurfacing work is now complete as has the work to remove dead trees and undergrowth the whole way along this path See Item 6 below..

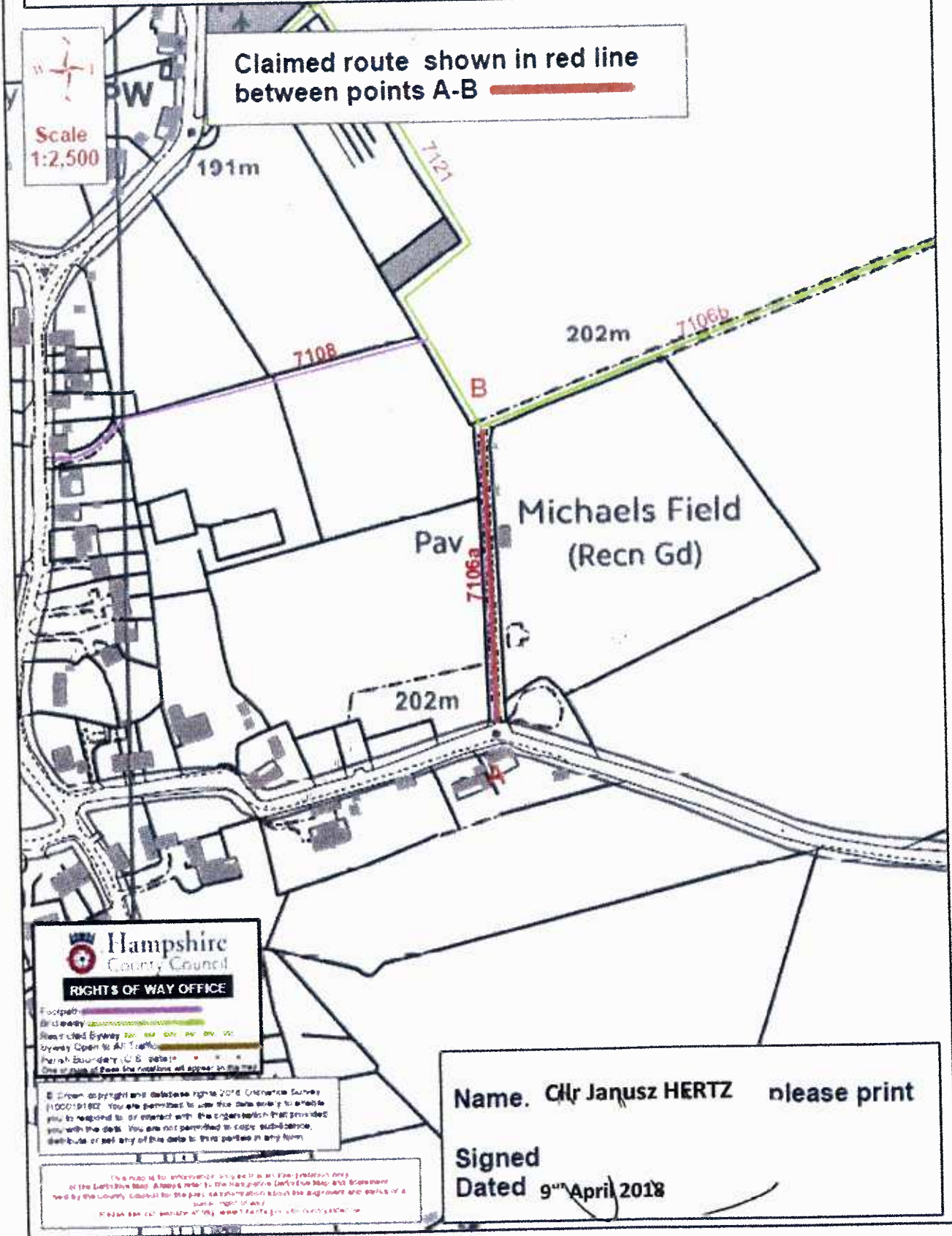

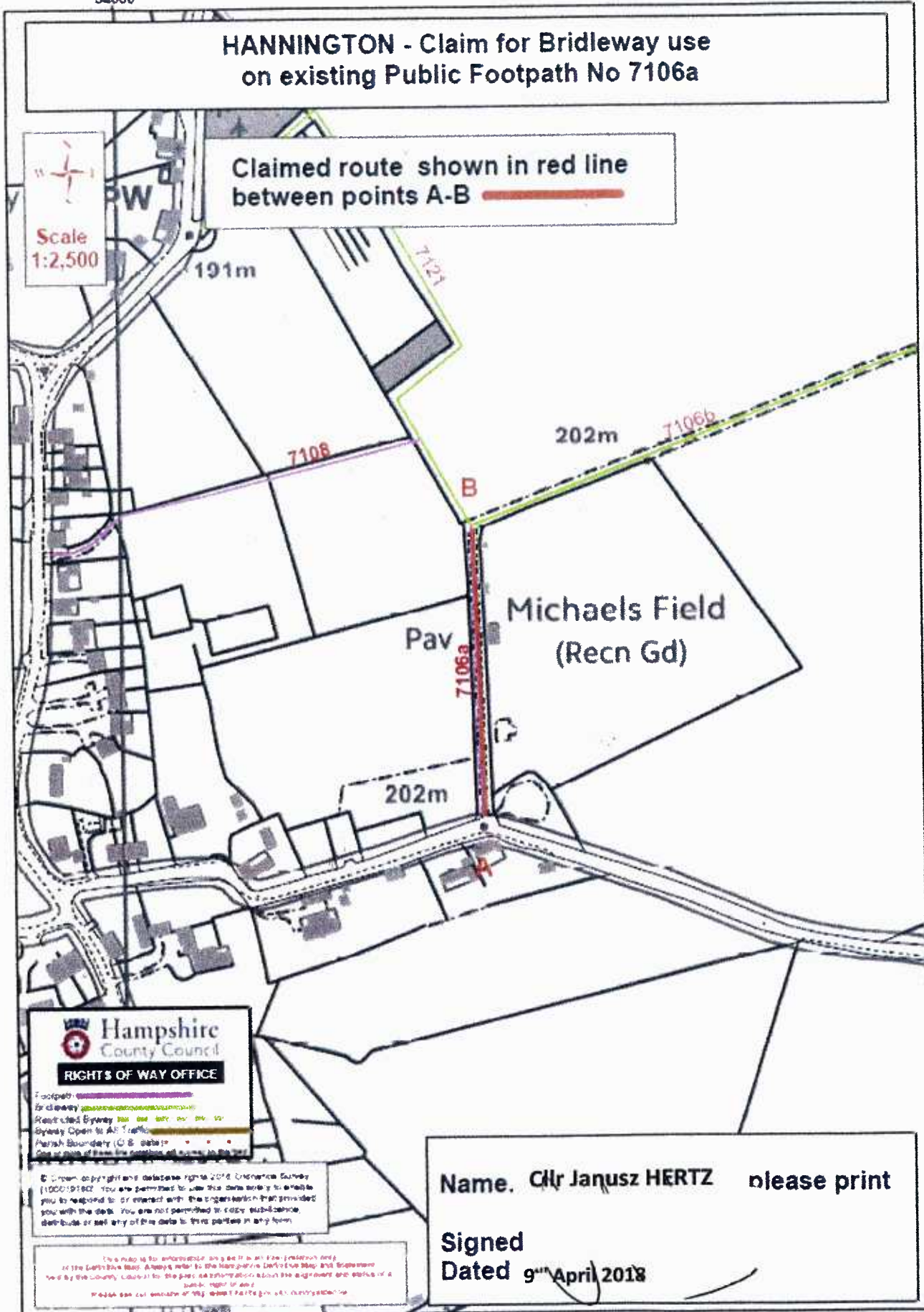
As the Owner or Occupier is unknown we cannot state their names.
