Herriard 9	Bridleway	6676 4378 Basingstoke Road	6503 4363 Bradley 2	<u>From Road A.339 to Parish Boundary at Herriard Common</u> From A.339 westwards along 12 ft. wide gravel track to Ash Copse then along earth track approximately 10 ft. wide, unenclosed through Middle Common Wood, then southwestwards along enclosed track between hedge and fir plantation to the Parish Boundary.
