<b>Lindford 702</b>	Footpath	8070 3622 Chase Road (U231)	8094 3622 Liphook Road	<p><u>From Road B.3004 to Road U.231 at Lindford</u></p> <p>From B.3004 westwards along metalled path approximately 6 ft. wide to Road U.231, Chase Road.</p> <p>This path was set out under the Headley Inclosure Award of 1859. Number 312 on Map A and of a width of 6 ft.</p>	
<b>Lindford 703</b>	Footpath	8092 3608 Windsor Road	8066 3617 Chase Road	<p><u>From Road B.3004 to U.231, Chase Road</u></p> <p>From B.3004 northwestwards along Taylor's Lane, a gravel occupation road, approximate width 20 ft. to Chase Road, U231.</p> <p>This road was set out under the Headley Inclosure award of 1859 "on Map A number 310A and of a width of 6 ft".</p>	
<b>Lindford 704</b>	Footpath	8044 3629 Whitehill 4 at Parish Boundary	8064 3618 Chase Road (U231)	<p><u>From Road A.325 to junction with Road U231</u></p> <p>From Road A.325, south southeastwards along 8 ft. wide cart track unenclosed across common, then southeastwards along 2 ft. wide path unenclosed across common, eastwards along 6 ft. wide grass track on verge of common on north side of wire fence, then southwards along 2 ft. wide earth path between sports ground and St. Lucia's Officer's Mess on east side of wire fence, crossing Road B.3002, south eastwards along 8 ft. wide metalled path through Bordon enclosure, over footbridge eastwards and south eastwards along 4 ft. wide metalled path and southeastwards along 20 ft. wide gravel road to junction with Road U.231.</p>

<b>Lindford 707</b>	Footpath	8056 3607 Chase Road	8062 3575 Whitehill 7 at Parish Boundary	<p><u>From Chase Road, U.231, to Road C.102</u></p> <p>From Road U.231 southwards along gravel occupation road known as Washford Lane, approximate width 12 ft. to staggered posts. This section shown on the Headley Inclosure Award dated 1859 as a path 6 ft. wide.</p> <p>Then along gravel track enclosed between banks and hedges to footbridge. This section shown on the Headley Parish Map dated 1857.</p>	The path follows a diverted route between 8064 3551 and 8066 3547

<i>Whitehill 7</i>	Footpath	8062 3575 Lindford 707 at Parish Boundary	8075 3523 Hollywater Road	Over footbridge 3 ft. wide, along gravel occupation road, approximate width 10 ft., to Road C.102 at Gas Works. This section shown on the Headley Inclosure Award dated 1859 as a path 6 ft. wide.  Across Road C.102, and southeastwards along gravel path, enclosed approximately 4 ft. wide between banks and hedges, to Road C.102 at Parish Boundary.	
<b>Lindford 744</b>	Footpath	8116 3574 Parish Boundary	8117 3574 Mill Chase Road (C102)	Approximately 2 metres wide
